THE TALE OF TWO BAD MICE, or, THE TALE OF TWO NAUGHTY MICE Beatrix Potter, 2018-10-01 The Tale of Two Bad Mice is a children's book written and illustrated by Beatrix Potter and published by Frederick Warne Co in September 1904 If the book were published today it would most likely be titled The Tale of Two Naughty Mice which having read the book is far more appropriate The tale is about two mice who vandalize a dollhouse After finding the food on the dining room table made of plaster they smash the dishes throw the doll clothing out the window tear the bolster and carry off a number of articles to their mouse hole When the little girl who owns the dollhouse discovers the destruction she positions a policeman doll outside the front door to ward off any future depredation The two mice atone for their crime spree by putting a crooked sixpence in the doll's stocking on Christmas Eve and sweeping the house every morning with a dust pan and broom Potter took inspiration for the tale from two mice caught in a cage trap in her cousin's home and a dollhouse being constructed by her editor and publisher Norman Warne as a Christmas gift for his niece Winifred While the tale was being developed Potter and Warne fell in love and became engaged much to the annoyance of Potter's parents who were grooming their daughter to be a permanent resident and housekeeper in their London home The tale's themes of rebellion insurrection and individualism reflect not only Potter's desire to free herself of her domineering parents and build a home of her own but her fears about independence and her frustrations with Victorian domesticity The book was critically well received and brought Potter her first fan letter from America The tale was adapted to a segment in the 1971 Royal Ballet film The Tales of Beatrix Potter and to an animated episode in the BBC series The World of Peter Rabbit and Friends Merchandise inspired by the tale includes Beswick Pottery porcelain figurines and Schmid music boxes

Rebirth in the Life and Works of Beatrix Potter Richard Tuerk, 2020-02-24 This work traces the concepts of initiation transformation and rebirth through Beatrix Potter's personal writings and her children's fiction Her letters and journals reveal attempts to escape from what she called her unloved birthplace and her overbearing parents Potter felt that her life culminated in her forties when she was in effect reborn through marriage as Mrs William Heelis a farmer raising Herdwick sheep and buying land for the National Trust From her first book *The Tale of Peter Rabbit* through some of the last such as *The Fairy Caravan* and *The Tale of Little Pig Robinson* central characters undergo processes of initiation during which they mature toward adulthood The most successful ones move from being helpless children to more mature creatures on their way to independence while others experience no change or even regression

THE TALE OF MRS TIGGY-WINKLE Beatrix Potter, 2018-10-01 *The Tale of Mrs Tiggy Winkle* is a children's story written and illustrated by Beatrix Potter Mrs Tiggy Winkle is a hedgehog washerwoman who lives in a tiny cottage in the fells of the Lake District A child named Lucie happens upon the cottage and stays for tea The two deliver freshly laundered clothing to the animals and birds in the neighbourhood Potter thought the book would be best enjoyed by girls and like most girls books of the period it is set indoors with a focus on housework Nevertheless the 14 colour illustrations and the setting make for an ideal children's story Potter's pet hedgehog Mrs Tiggy Winkle and Kitty MacDonald a Scottish washerwoman were the inspirations for the eponymous heroine Lucie Carr a child friend of Potter's was the model for the fictional Lucie Potter's *Peter Rabbit* and Benjamin Bunny make cameo appearances in the illustrations The Newlands Valley and the surrounding fells are the sources for the backgrounds in the illustrations NOTE Mrs Tiggy Winkle has been described as one of Potter's most positive creations but critics consider Lucie an artistic failure Although Mrs Tiggy Winkle is set in an identifiable place and time period the tale is mythologized by reaching back to an age when household chores were performed manually and without the aid of modern mechanical inventions The simple dwellings rustic pathways and stone fences enhance the tale's timeless aspect and suggest an unchanging countryside and its way of life

Mouse, 2018-09-08 Contained herein are all 15 verses to this well known children's poem But who was the original author of the nursery rhyme Jack and Jill who went up the hill In truth no one knows It is thought to be a nonsense poem although there are a few truisms contained in the lines In the 18thC vinegar and brown paper were used to draw bruises out But who ever heard of someone going uphill to draw water In most cases people talking about going down to the river or well to draw water The phrase Jack and Jill was in use in England as early as the 16th century to indicate a boy and a girl A comedy with the title Jack and Jill was performed at the Elizabethan court in 1567 68 and the phrase was used twice by Shakespeare in A Midsummer Night's Dream but the poem did not eventuate until the 18th C We know this because the earliest known printed version comes from a reprint of John Newbery's Mother Goose's Melody thought to have been first published in London around 1765 Here we have used the illustrated edition published by publisher J Aldis first name unknown of London in 1806 That this volume with illustrations has survived for over 200 years is to say the least amazing So we invite you to download a copy of this highly amusing but accident prone pair to read to your children at bedtime No doubt as they discover the new verses they will have you reading and re-reading this book's time and again

NOTE After two full length tales about rabbits Potter had grown weary of the subject and was reluctant to write another She realized however that children most enjoyed her rabbit stories and pictures and so reached back to

Rabbit as he is chased about the garden of Mr McGregor after eating vegetables he wasn't supposed to. After a few tight scrapes he escapes but loses his shoes and jacket in his scramble for freedom. He returns home to his mother who puts him to bed after giving him some camomile tea. The tale was written and exquisitely illustrated by Potter for five year old Noel Moore son of Potter's former governess Annie Carter Moore in 1893. It was revised and privately printed by Potter in 1901 but was printed in a trade edition by Frederick Warne Co in 1902. The book was a success and multiple reprints were issued in the years immediately following its debut. It has been translated into 36 languages and with 45 million copies sold it is one of the best selling books of all time.
