for human dignity and freedom interpreted as empowerment and self determination whilst acknowledging our inter subjective identities In drawing on socio legal philosophical biological and feminist outlooks this book is truly interdisciplinary and will be of great interest and use to scholars and students of human rights law legal and social theory gender and cultural studies
