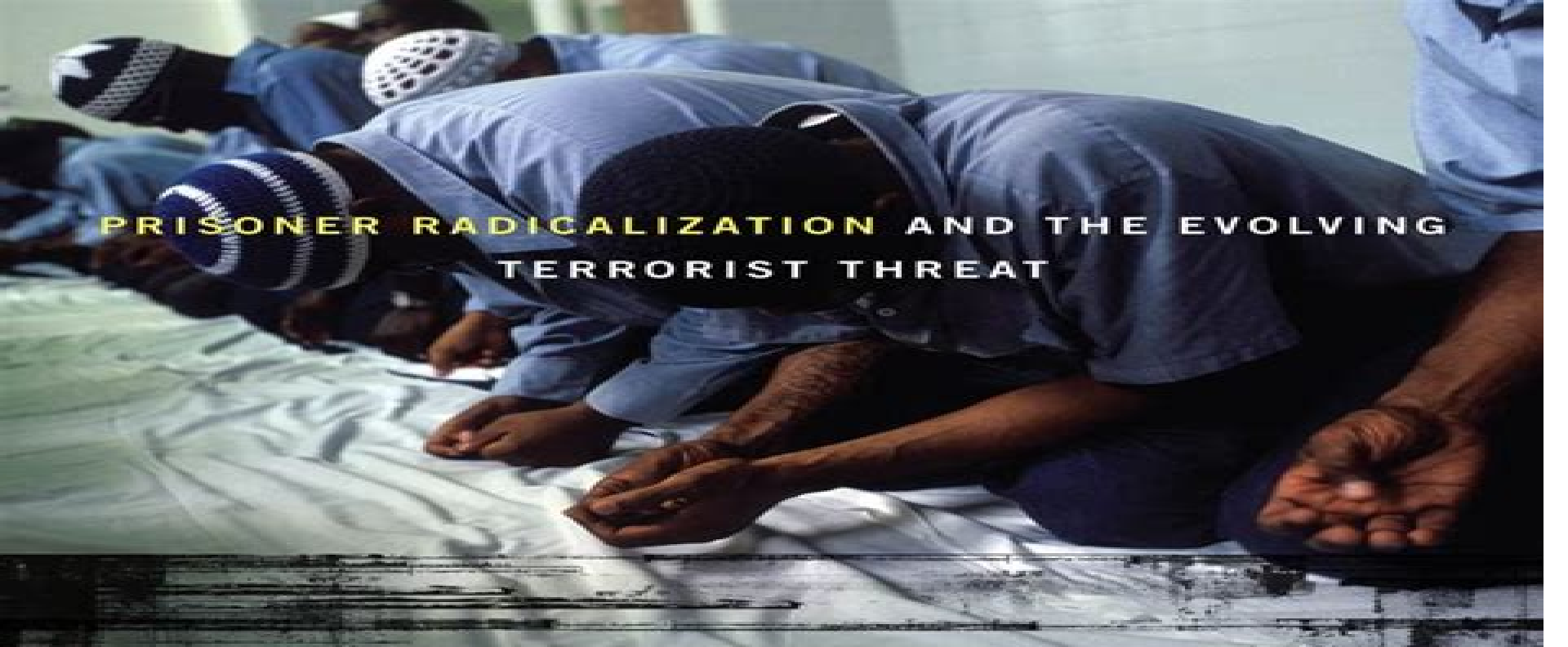

Drawing from a wide range of sources, *The Spectacular Few* imagines the texture of prisoners' lives. Hamm covers their criminal thinking styles, the social networks that influenced them, and personal turning points that set them on the pathway to violent extremism. Hamm argues that in order to understand terrorism today, we must come to terms with how prisoners are treated behind bars. Mark S. The New True Crime Diana Rickard,2023-09-05 How serialized crime shows became an American obsession TV shows and podcasts like Making a Murderer Serial and Atlanta Monster have taken the cultural zeitgeist by storm and contributed to the release of wrongly imprisoned people such as Adnan Syed The popularity of these long form true crime docuseries has sparked greater attention to issues of inequality power social class and structural racism More and more the American public is asking Who is and is not deserving of punishment and who is and is not protected by the law In The New True Crime Diana Rickard argues that these new true crime series deserve our attention for what they reveal about our societal understanding of crime and punishment and for the new light they shine on the inequalities of the criminal justice system Questioning the finality of verdicts framing facts as in the eye of the beholder these new series unmoor our faith in what is knowable even as Rickard critically notes they often blur the lines between fact and fiction With a focus on some of the most popular true crime podcasts and streaming series of the last decade Rickard provides an in depth analysis of the ways in which this new media which allows for binge listening or watching makes crime into a public spectacle and conveys ideological messages about punishment to its audience Entertainment values have always been entwined with crime news reporting Newsworthy stories Rickard reminds us need to involve sex violence or a famous person and contain events that can be framed in terms of individualism and conservative ideologies about crime Even as these old tropes of innocent victims and deviant bad guys still dominate these docuseries Rickard also unpacks how the new true crime has been influenced by the innocence movement a diverse group of organizers and activists be they journalists lawyers formerly incarcerated people or family members who now have a place in mainstream consciousness as DNA evidence exonerates the wrongly convicted The New True Crime questions the knowability of truth and probes our anxieties about the real nature of true crime media For fans of true crime shows and anyone concerned about justice in America this book will prove to be essential reading

Comic Book Crime

Nickie D. Phillips, Staci Strobl, 2013-07-15 Superman Batman Daredevil and Wonder Woman are iconic cultural figures that embody values of order fairness justice and retribution *Comic Book Crime* digs deep into these and other celebrated characters providing a comprehensive understanding of crime and justice in contemporary American comic books This is a world where justice is delivered where heroes save ordinary citizens from certain doom where evil is easily identified and thwarted by powers far greater than mere mortals could possess Nickie Phillips and Staci Strobl explore these representations and show that comic books as a historically important American cultural medium participate in both reflecting and shaping an American ideological identity that is often focused on ideas of the apocalypse utopia retribution and nationalism Through an analysis of approximately 200 comic books sold from 2002 to 2010 as well as several years of immersion in comic book fan culture Phillips and Strobl reveal the kinds of themes and plots popular comics feature in a post 9 11 context They discuss heroes calculations of deathworthiness or who should be killed in meting out justice and how these judgments have as much to do with the hero s character as they do with the actions of the villains This fascinating volume also analyzes how class race ethnicity gender and sexual orientation are used to construct difference for both the heroes and the villains in ways that are both conservative and progressive Engaging sharp and insightful *Comic Book Crime* is a fresh take on the very meaning of truth justice and the American way

Halfway House Liam Martin, 2021-10-19 *Halfway House* draws on three and a half years of intensive ethnographic fieldwork to open a window on the little known web of organizations governing prisoner reentry at the frontier of mass incarceration It tells the story of Joe Badillo along with a small cast of connected characters by following the ups and downs of his unfolding experience as he leaves jail and searches for a place in the world outside while confronting overwhelming obstacles Joe s first stop after release is Bridge House and the author moves into the program as a researcher around the same time he arrives the beginnings of the long term collaboration at the heart of the book This deeply personal account is weaved into a larger analysis of the halfway house as an institution a site of punishment and carceral control as well as housing and social support With a national push underway for decarceration and alternatives to imprisonment it provides an opportunity to rethink the pitfalls and possibilities of using the halfway house to challenge the worst excesses of mass incarceration

The Little Old Lady Killer Susana Vargas Cervantes, 2019-08-20 The surprising true story of Mexico s hunt arrest and conviction of its first female serial killer For three years amid widespread public outrage police in Mexico City struggled to uncover the identity of the killer responsible for the ghastly deaths of forty elderly women many of whom had been strangled in their homes with a stethoscope by someone posing as a government nurse When Juana Barraza Samperio a female professional wrestler known as la Dama del Silencio the Lady of Silence was arrested and eventually sentenced to 759 years in prison for her crimes as the Mataviejitas the little old lady killer her case disrupted traditional narratives about gender criminality and victimhood in the popular and criminological imagination Marshaling ten years of research and one of the only interviews that Juana Barraza Samperio has

given while in prison Susana Vargas Cervantes deconstructs this uniquely provocative story She focuses in particular on the complex gendered aspects of the case asking Who is a killer Barraza with her manly features and strength her career as a masked wrestler in lucha libre and her violent crimes is presented here as a study in gender deviance a disruption of what scholars call mexicanidad or the masculine notion of what it means to be Mexican Cervantes also challenges our conception of victimhood specifically who counts as a victim The Little Old Lady Killer presents a fascinating analysis of what serial killing often considered killing for the pleasure of killing represents to us Policing Pain Kevin Revier,2025-11-11 How the medicalization of addiction during the U S opioid crisis has driven mass incarceration and mass policing in rural and deindustrialized communities The nationwide opioid public health emergency has led many advocates and public officials to call for drug policy reforms that reject traditional law and order approaches In Policing Pain Kevin Revier approaches the opioid epidemic from an abolitionist framework that seeks to treat people who use opioids not as so called criminals but as people in need of health care Based on two years of ethnographic research in Upstate New York a region highly impacted by overdoses job loss and deindustrialization Revier shows that incorporation of treatment within the criminal justice system has ultimately expanded the scope of the drug war turning individuals into treatable carceral subjects who are both medicalized and criminalized He argues that the incorporation of medical rhetoric and treatment within the criminal legal system maintains a carceral approach in rural and low income areas facing high rates of opioid overdose and economic disinvestment further entrenching the carceral state in the lives of people who use drugs Ultimately Policing Pain explores alternative strategies to promote harm reduction from an abolitionist ethic of care that advocates for people who use drugs while seeking to minimize criminal justice involvement in drug related issues **America's Jails** Derek Jeffreys,2018-06-05 A look at the contemporary crisis in U S jails with recommendations for improving and protecting the dignity of inmates Twelve million Americans go through the U S jail system on an annual basis Jails which differ significantly from prisons are designed to house inmates for short amounts of time and are often occupied by large populations of legally innocent people waiting for a trial Jails often have deplorable sanitary conditions and there are countless records of inmates being brutalized by staff and other inmates while in custody Local municipalities use jails to institutionalize those whom they perceive to be a threat so hundreds of thousands of inmates suffer from mental illness People abandoned by families or lacking health insurance or those who cannot afford bail often cycle in and out of jails In America s Jails Derek Jeffreys draws on sociology philosophy history and his personal experience volunteering in jails and prisons to provide an understanding of the jail experience from the inmates perspective focusing on the stigma that surrounds incarceration Using his research at Cook County Jail the nation s largest single site jail Jeffreys attests that jail inmates possess an inherent dignity that should govern how we treat them Ultimately fundamental changes in the U S jail system are necessary and America s Jails provides specific policy recommendations for changing its poor conditions Highlighting the experiences of inmates themselves America s Jails

Spaaij,2017-05-09 The lethality of lone wolf terrorism has reached an all time high in the United States Isolated individuals using firearms with high capacity magazines are committing brutally efficient killings with the aim of terrorizing others yet there is little consensus on what connects these crimes and the motivations behind them In *The Age of Lone Wolf Terrorism* terrorism experts Mark S Hamm and Ram n Spaaij combine criminological theory with empirical and ethnographic research to map the pathways of lone wolf radicalization helping with the identification of suspected behaviors and recognizing patterns of indoctrination Reviewing comprehensive data on these actors including more than two hundred terrorist incidents Hamm and Spaaij find that a combination of personal and political grievances lead lone wolves to befriend online sympathizers whether jihadists white supremacists or other antigovernment extremists and then announce their intent to commit terror when triggered Hamm and Spaaij carefully distinguish between lone wolves and individuals radicalized within a group dynamic This important difference is what makes this book such a significant manual for professionals seeking richer insight into the transformation of alienated individuals into armed warriors Hamm and Spaaij conclude with an analysis of recent FBI sting operations designed to prevent lone wolf terrorism in the United States describing who gets targeted strategies for luring suspects and the ethics of arresting and prosecuting citizens

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
