The central role of plastids in many aspects of plant cell biology means an in depth understanding is key for a holistic view of plant physiology Despite the vast amount of research the molecular details of many aspects of plastid biology remains limited Plastids possess their own high copy number genome known as the plastome Manipulation of the plastid genome has been developed as an alternative way to developing transgenic plants for various biotechnological applications High copy number of the plastome site specific integration of transgenes through homologous recombination and potential to express proteins at high levels 70% of total soluble proteins has been reported in some cases are some of the technologies being developed Additionally plastids are inherited maternally providing a natural gene containment system and do not follow Mendelian laws of inheritance allowing each individual member of the progeny of a transplastomic line to uniformly express transgene s Both algal and higher plant chloroplast transformation has been demonstrated and with the ability to be propagated either in bioreactors or in the field both systems are well suited for scale up of production The manipulation of chloroplast genes is also essential for many approaches that attempt to increase biomass accumulation or re-routing metabolic pathways for biofortification food and fuel production This includes metabolic engineering for lipid production adapting the light harvesting apparatus to improve solar
