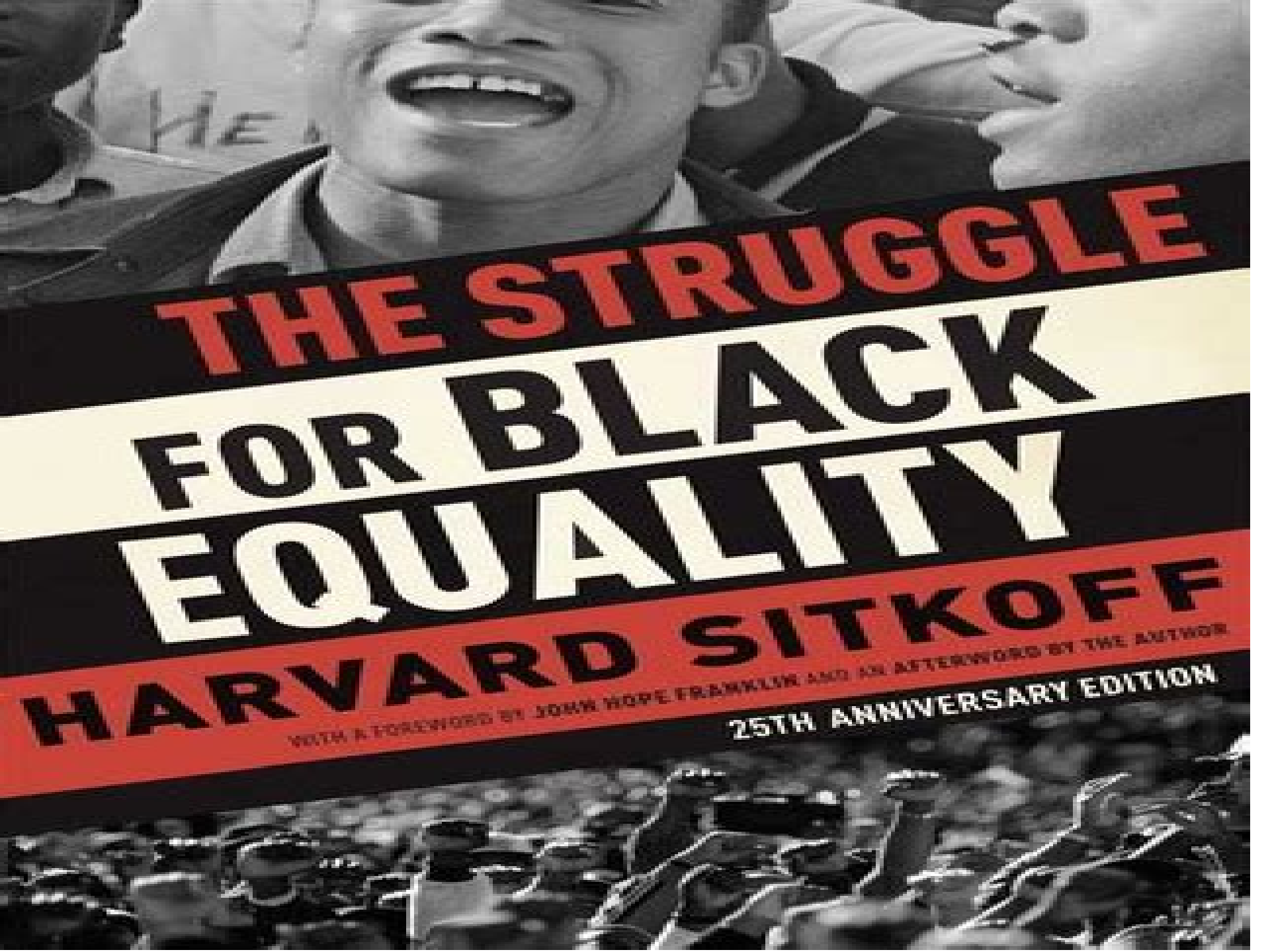




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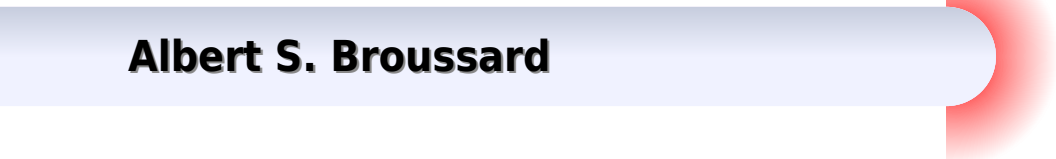

The Struggle for Black Equality, 1954-1992 Harvard Sitkoff, 1993 The Struggle for Black Equality is an arresting history of the civil rights movement from the pathbreaking Supreme Court decision of 1954 *Brown v Board of Education of Topeka* Kansas through the growth of strife and conflict in the 1960s to the major issues of the 1990s harvard Sitkoff offers not only a brilliant interpretation of the personalities and dynamics of the civils rights organization SNCC CORE NAACP SCLC and others but a superb study of the continuing problems plaguing the African American population the future that in 1980 seemed to hold much promise for a better way of life has by the early 1990s hardly lived up to expectations Jim Crow has gone but forty years after *Brown* poverty big city slums white backlash politically and socially conservative policies and prolonged recession have made economic progress for the vast majority of blacks an elusive perhaps ever more distant goal All Americans who strove and suffered to make democracy real come vividly to life in these compelling pages

The Struggle for Black Equality Harvard Sitkoff, 1991 **Black San Francisco** Albert S. Broussard, 1993-04-26 By 1867 black San Franciscans had gained access to public transportation In 1869 they were granted the right to vote by the state of California In 1875 they fought for desegregated schools and won Yet in 1957 Willie Mays was initially denied the opportunity to purchase a home in an exclusive San Francisco neighborhood because he was black In *Black San Francisco* Albert Broussard explores race relations in a city where whites for the most part were outwardly civil to blacks while denying them employment opportunities and political power Understanding the texture of the racial caste system he argues is critical to understanding why blacks made so little progress in employment housing and politics despite the absence of segregation laws When it came to racial equality in the early twentieth century Broussard argues the liberal progressive image of San Francisco was largely a facade Illustrating how black San Franciscans struggled to achieve equality in the same manner as their counterparts in the Midwest and East he challenges the rhetoric of progress and opportunity with evidence of the reality of inequality for black San Franciscans *Black San Francisco* is considerably broader in scope than any previous study of African Americans in the West It provides extensive coverage of the city s black community during the Great Depression and the New Deal details civil rights activities from 1915 to 1954 and provides extensive biographical material on local black leaders In his reconstruction of the plight of San Francisco s black citizens Broussard reveals a population that despite its small size before 1940 did not accept second class citizenship passively yet remained nonviolent into the 1960s He also shows how World War II was a watershed for Black San Francisco

bringing thousands of southern migrants to the bay area to work in the war industries These migrants in tandem with native black residents formed coalitions with white liberals to attack racial inequality more vigorously and successfully than at any previous time in San Francisco s history From Rights to Economics Timothy J. Lau,2014-10-17 Considered by many historians to be the birthplace of the Confederacy South Carolina experienced one of the longest and most turbulent Reconstruction periods of all the southern states After the Civil War white supremacist leadership in the state fiercely resisted the efforts of freed slaves to secure full citizenship rights and to remake society based upon an expansive vision of freedom forged in slavery and the crucible of war Despite numerous obstacles African Americans achieved remarkable social and political advances in the ten years following the war including the establishment of the state s first publicly funded school system and health care for the poor Through their efforts the state s political process and social fabric became more democratic Peter F Lau traces the civil rights movement in South Carolina from Reconstruction through the early twenty first century He stresses that the movement was shaped by local national and international circumstances in which individuals worked to redefine and expand the meaning and practice of democracy beyond the borders of their own state Contrary to recent scholars who separate civil rights claims from general calls for economic justice Lau asserts that African American demands for civil rights have been inseparable from broader demands for a redistribution of social and economic power Using the

creatures seduced men into dancing until they died punishment for inconstancy or lured them into love For Cloud the dark gravity that holds these enchanters to the earth is the same as our own and thus these demons are as everyday as air Sylph filters our world through the lenses of dance folklore and history revealing our contemporary lives to be dreamlike and prismatic In the blink the mouse spent to disappear I loved you avows the sylph The cost of her ascension and ours is steep our price speech our forgetting breath Such are the stakes in this complex seductive and stunning debut *The Possessive Investment in Whiteness* George Lipsitz, 2009-08-21 A widely influential book revised to reveal racial privilege at work in the 21st century *Divided We Stand* Bruce Nelson, 2002-01-15 *Divided We Stand* is a study of how class and race have intersected in American society above all in the making and remaking of the American working class in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries Focusing mainly on longshoremen in the ports of New York New Orleans and Los Angeles and on steelworkers in many of the nation's steel towns it examines how European immigrants became American and white in the crucible of the industrial workplace and the ethnic and working class neighborhood As workers organized on the job especially during the overlapping CIO and civil rights eras in the middle third of the twentieth century trade unions became a vital arena in which old and new immigrants and black migrants forged new alliances and identities and tested the limits not only of class solidarity but of American democracy The most volatile force in this regard was the civil rights movement As it crested in the 1950s and 60s the Movement confronted unions anew with the question Which side are you on This book demonstrates the complex ways in which labor organizations answered that question and the complex relationships between union leaders and diverse rank and file constituencies in addressing it *Divided We Stand* includes vivid examples of white working class agency in the construction of racially discriminatory employment structures But Nelson is less concerned with racism as such than with the concrete historical circumstances in which racialized class identities emerged and developed This leads him to a detailed and often fascinating consideration of white working class ethnicity but also to a careful analysis of black workers their conditions of work their aspirations and identities their struggles for equality Making its case with passion and clarity *Divided We Stand* will be a compelling and controversial book **NAACP Youth and the Fight for Black Freedom, 1936-1965** Thomas Bynum, 2013-08-30 Historical studies of black youth activism have until now focused almost exclusively on the activities of the Congress of Racial Equality CORE and the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee SNCC However the NAACP youth councils and college chapters predate both of those organizations They initiated grassroots organizing efforts and nonviolent direct action tactics as early as the 1930s and in doing so made significant contributions to the struggle for racial equality in the United States This deeply researched book breaks new ground in an important and compelling area of study Thomas Bynum carefully examines the activism of the NAACP youth and effectively refutes the perception of the NAACP as working strictly through the courts His research illuminates the many direct action activities undertaken by the young people of the NAACP activities that helped precipitate the breakdown of

racial discrimination and segregation in America Beginning with the formal organization of the NAACP youth movement under Juanita Jackson the author traces the group's activities from their early anti lynching demonstrations through their post World War II withholding patronage campaigns to their participation in the sit in protests of the 1960s He also explores the evolution of the youth councils and college chapters including their sometime rocky relationship with the national office and shows how these groups actually provided a framework for the emergence of youth activism within CORE and SNCC The author provides a comprehensive account of the generational struggle for racial equality capturing the successes failures and challenges the NAACP youth groups experienced at the national state and local levels He firmly establishes the vital role they played in the history of the civil rights movement in the United States and in the burgeoning tradition of youth activism in the postwar decades
