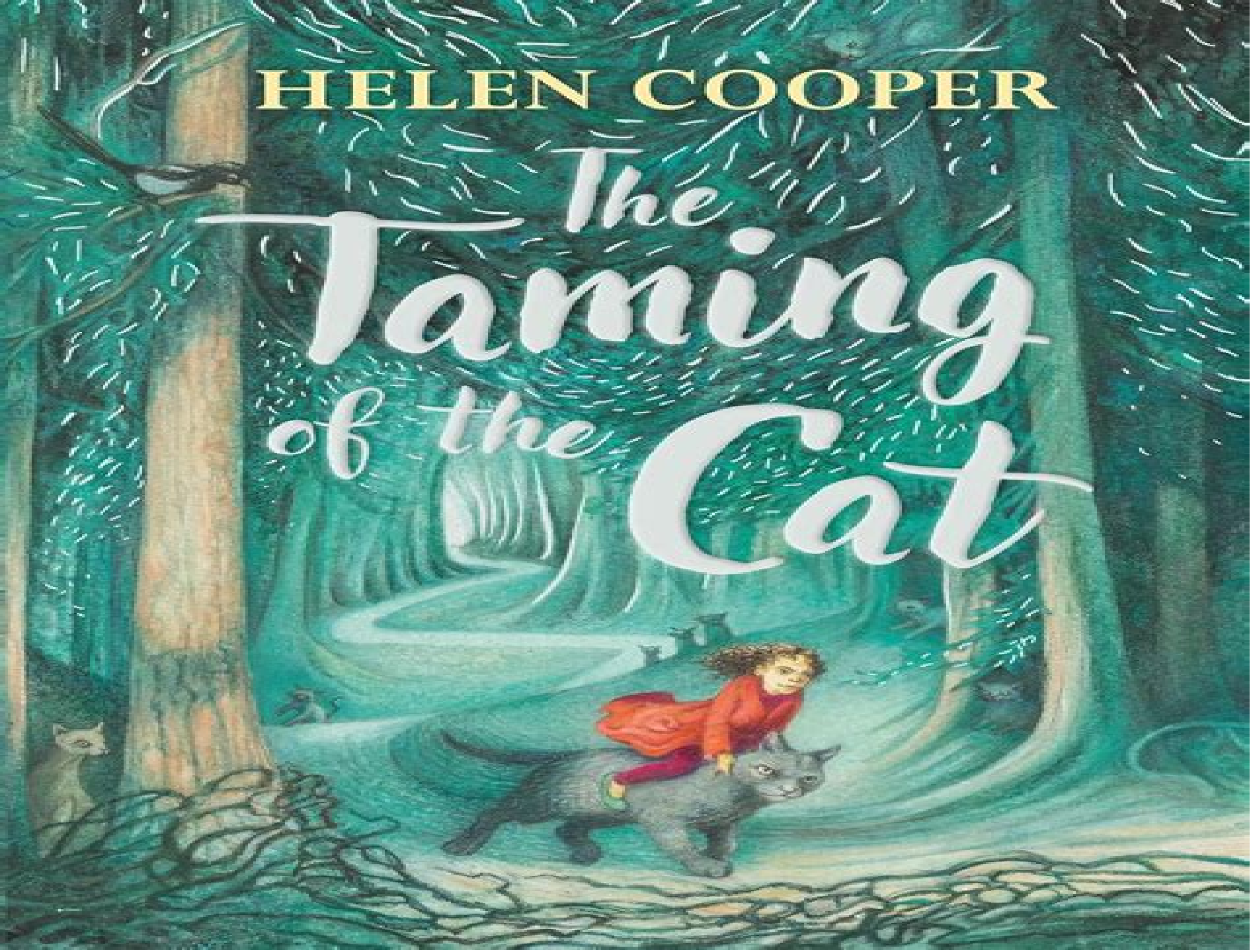

The Taming Of The True:

The Taming of the True Neil Tennant, 1997 The Taming of the True poses a broad challenge to the realist views of meaning and truth that have been prominent in recent philosophy Neil Tennant starts with a careful critical survey of the realism debate guiding the reader through its complexities he then presents a sustained defence of the anti realist view that every truth is knowable in principle and that grasp of meaning must be able to be made manifest Sceptical arguments for the indeterminacy or non factuality of meaning are countered and the much maligned notion of analyticity is reinvestigated and rehabilitated Tennant goes on to show that an effective logical system can be based on his anti realist view the logical system that he advocates is justified as a body of analytic truths and inferential principles Having laid the foundations for global semantic anti realism Tennant moves to the world of empirical understanding and gives an account of the cognitive credentials of natural scientific discourse He shows that the same canon of constructive and relevant inference suffices both for intuitionistic mathematics and for empirical science This is an ambitious and contentious book which aims to reform not only theory of meaning but our deductive practices across a broad range of discourses **Truth** Pascal Engel, 2002-09-18

Engel argues that although the minimalist conception of truth is basically right it does not follow that truth can be eliminated from our philosophical thinking as is claimed by some radical deflationists In particular he shows that some deflationist views have a definitively relativist and postmodernist ring and should be rejected Even if a metaphysically substantive theory of truth has little chance to succeed he argues truth plays a central role as a norm or guiding value of our rational inquiries and practices in the philosophy of knowledge and in ethics *Things New and Old in Discourses of Christian Truth and Life*

Washington Gladden, 1883 **The Knowability Paradox** Jonathan L. Kvanvig, 2006-02-09 The paradox of knowability derived from a proof by Frederic Fitch in 1963 is one of the deepest paradoxes concerning the nature of truth Jonathan Kvanvig argues that the depth of the paradox has not been adequately appreciated It has long been known that the paradox threatens antirealist conceptions of truth according to which truth is epistemic If truth is epistemic what better way to express that idea than to maintain that all truths are knowable In the face of the paradox however such a characterization threatens to undermine antirealism If Fitch's proof is valid then one can be an antirealist of this sort only by endorsing the conclusion of the proof that all truths are known Realists about truth have tended to stand on the sidelines and cheer the difficulties faced by their opponents from Fitch's proof Kvanvig argues that this perspective is wholly unwarranted He argues that there are two problems raised by the paradox one that threatens antirealism about truth and the other that threatens everybody's view about truth realist or antirealist The problem facing antirealism has had a number of proposed solutions over the past 40 years and the results have not been especially promising with regard to the first problem The second problem has not even been acknowledged however and the proposals regarding the first problem are irrelevant to the second problem This book thus provides a thorough investigation of the literature on the paradox and also proposes a solution to the

deeper of the two problems raised by Fitch's proof. It provides a complete picture of the paradoxicality that results from Fitch's proof and presents a solution to the paradox that claims to address both problems raised by the original proof. Shakespeare Eric Sams,1997-01-01 One of the central assumptions of established Shakespeare scholarship has been that the playwright produced flawless work needing no revision that if a text was inferior in style it could be assumed that Shakespeare did not write it Thus Shakespeare had nothing to do with the bad quartos these were instead the work of memorial reconstruction in which actors remembered and subsequently wrote down entire texts composed by others In this controversial book Eric Sams suggests that there is no evidence to substantiate memorial reconstruction that Shakespeare very probably revised his plays repeatedly and that he may therefore be the author of the bad quartos and of other works not attributed to him Drawing on testimony from Shakespeare s contemporaries and on documents concerning his family Sams presents a vivid biographical picture of the first thirty years of the playwright s life He establishes that Shakespeare s origins were humble his parents were illiterate Catholics and the family trade was farming and animal husbandry During this period Shakespeare acquired some knowledge of legal practice served as the legal hand in an attorney s office married and moved to London to join a theatre company and to establish a career as an actor and playwright Sams traces the impact of Shakespeare s upbringing in the plays themselves not only those of the Folio edition but others including the bad quartos He finds that these texts are filled with figurative language that would have been gleaned from a rural upbringing and legal experience Using detailed textual analysis he argues compellingly that during these early lost years Shakespeare was in fact writing first versions of his later great works
