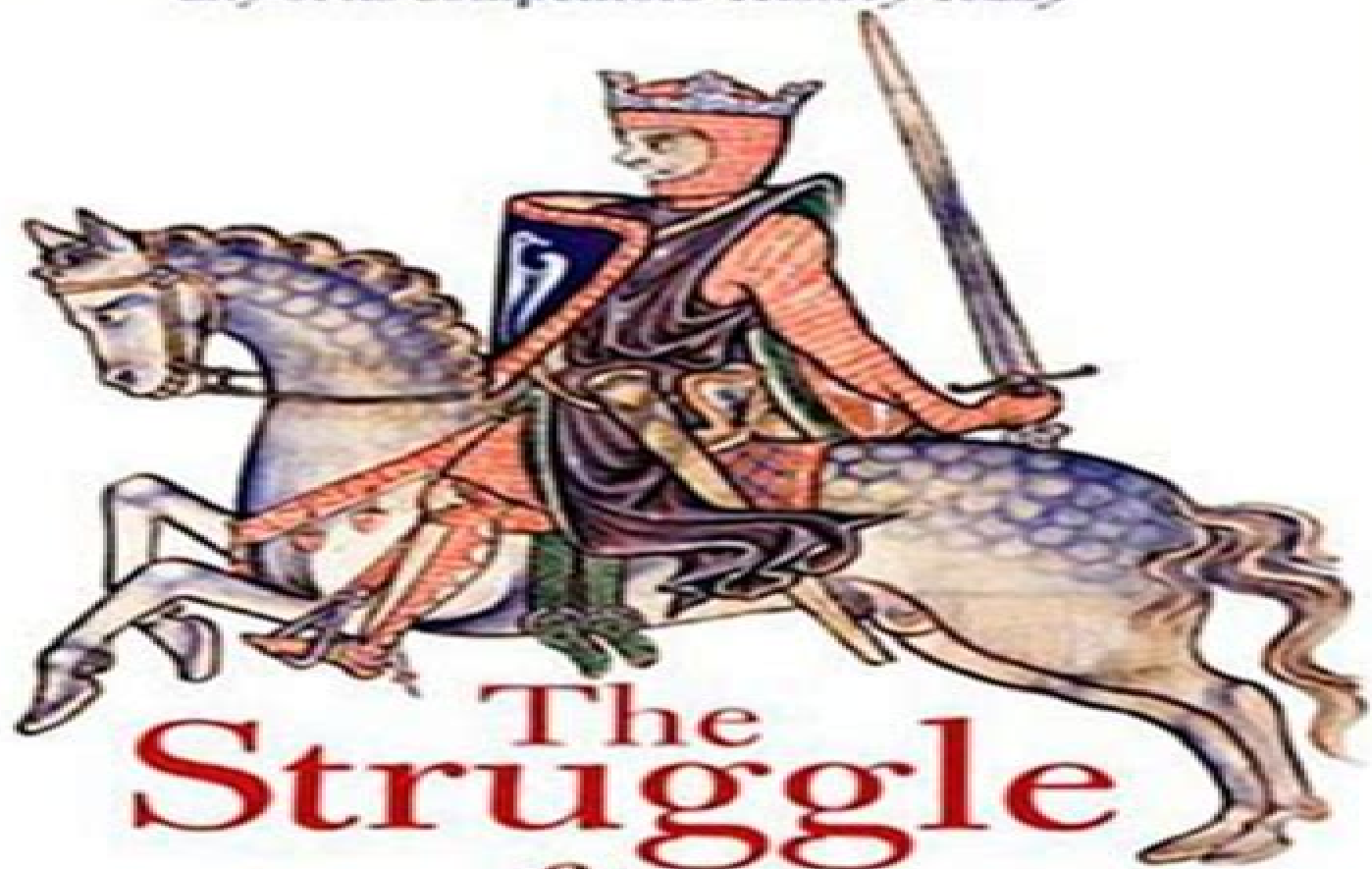

The Norman Conquest Hugh M.
