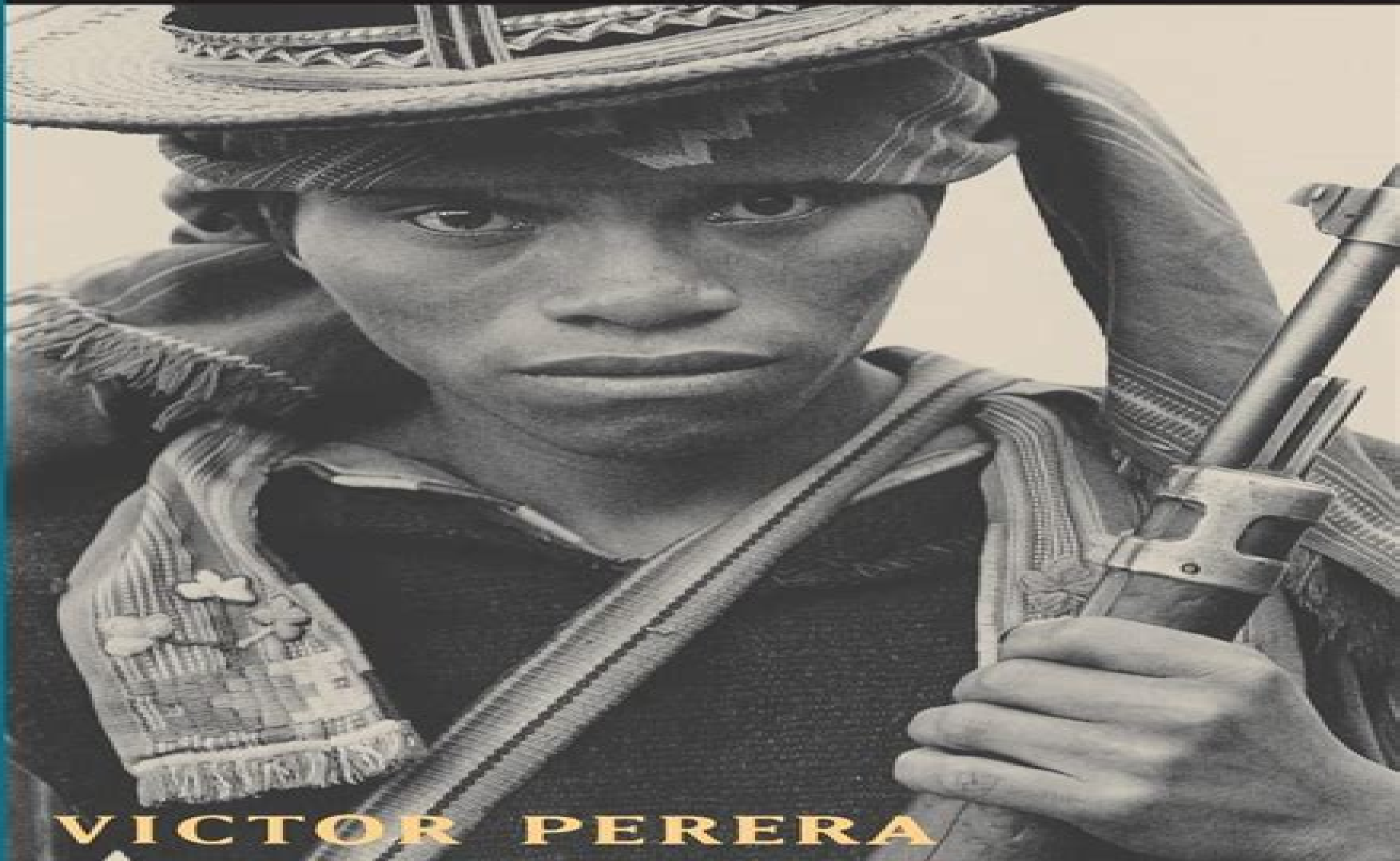

Miller,2024-09-30 Arguably all of Guatemalan writer Eduardo Halfon s fictional works deal with quandaries of translation even in their original versions The award winning author of fifteen books claims to have lost his mother tongue when his family fled to the United States after his tenth birthday This displacement echoing the displacement of his four grandparents from different corners of the Jewish diaspora to Guatemala gives Halfon like his ancestors before him good reason to consider translation a natural environment for his creative work and for life itself Indeed Halfon s uncanny ability to translate his family s history into fictions that resonate across the globe with readers in Spanish English and several other languages helps explain why he has received numerous prizes in the United States Spain Guatemala and even France some as a Latin American author others as a Latino or Jewish author Marilyn G Miller has written the first study to focus exclusively on this important voice in Jewish Latin American letters Only after returning to Guatemala and regaining his command of Spanish through reading literature did Halfon begin to build his life as a writer and translator Nonetheless the author admits that one thing is stubbornly true and it s this every sentence that I write every verb or adjective that I painstakingly insert or remove every literary thought that I have while writing always begins and ends in English Halfon s translated works are never parallel texts however Thus translation and its side effects foreign words linguistic lacunae multilingual modes of perception offer us crucial keys to understanding the author s fictional world as a vehicle for retelling and surviving Jewish trauma and finding his own particular plurilingual voice The Maya of Morganton Leon

Fink,2024-10-11 In 2003 Leon Fink published his oral history of Guatemalan and Mexican migrants in Morganton North Carolina and their fight for unionization in a poultry processing plant In the following years Fink remained in touch with many of the people he profiled in the book and in 2022 he returned to Morganton to interview them and talk with their children new migrants in the area and community leaders particularly women Their conversations covered a wide range of topics including labor struggles and victories grassroots and electoral political organizing social activism especially on issues affecting undocumented migrants class mobility for second generation migrants and new cooperative worker owned institutions including a bookstore a textile factory and a preschool This revised and expanded edition of The Maya of Morganton reveals what Fink found on his return to Morganton documenting two decades of continuity and change in a new preface and chapter Together the new and original material present a comprehensive yet intimate examination of the migrant experience in western North Carolina **Voices from Exile** Victor Montejo,1999 Elilal exile is the condition of thousands of Mayas who have fled their homelands in Guatemala to escape repression and even death at the hands of their

government In this book Victor Montejo who is both a Maya expatriate and an anthropologist gives voice to those who until now have struggled in silence but who nevertheless have found ways to reaffirm and celebrate their Mayaness Voices from Exile is the authentic story of one group of Mayas from the Kuchumatan highlands who fled into Mexico and sought refuge there Montejo s combination of autobiography history political analysis and testimonial narrative offers a profound exploration of state terror and its inescapable human cost

George Lovell, 2014-05-14 Though a 1996 peace accord brought a formal end to a conflict that had lasted for thirty six years Guatemala s violent past continues to scar its troubled present and seems destined to haunt its uncertain future George Lovell brings to this revised and expanded edition of A Beauty That Hurts decades of fieldwork throughout Guatemala as well as archival research He locates the roots of conflict in geographies of inequality that arose during colonial times and were exacerbated by the drive to develop Guatemala s resources in the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries The lines of confrontation were entrenched after a decade of socioeconomic reform between 1944 and 1954 saw modernizing initiatives undone by a military coup backed by U S interests and the CIA A United Nations Truth Commission has established that civil war in Guatemala claimed the lives of more than 200 000 people the vast majority of them indigenous Mayas Lovell weaves documentation about what happened to Mayas in particular during the war years with accounts of their difficult personal situations Meanwhile an intransigent elite and a powerful military continue to benefit from the inequalities that triggered armed insurrection in the first place Weak and corrupt civilian governments fail to impose the rule of law thus ensuring that Guatemala remains an embattled country where postwar violence and drug related crime undermine any semblance of orderly peaceful life

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
