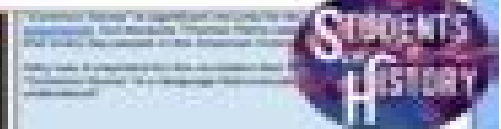

	1901: The Progressive Era ended.	
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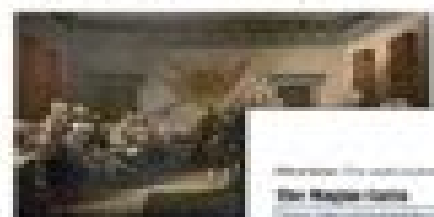

The idea of a government that is limited in power is a key principle of American government. This is reflected in the Constitution, which sets out the powers of the federal government and the states. The Bill of Rights, which was added to the Constitution in 1791, further limits the power of the government by protecting the rights of citizens.
