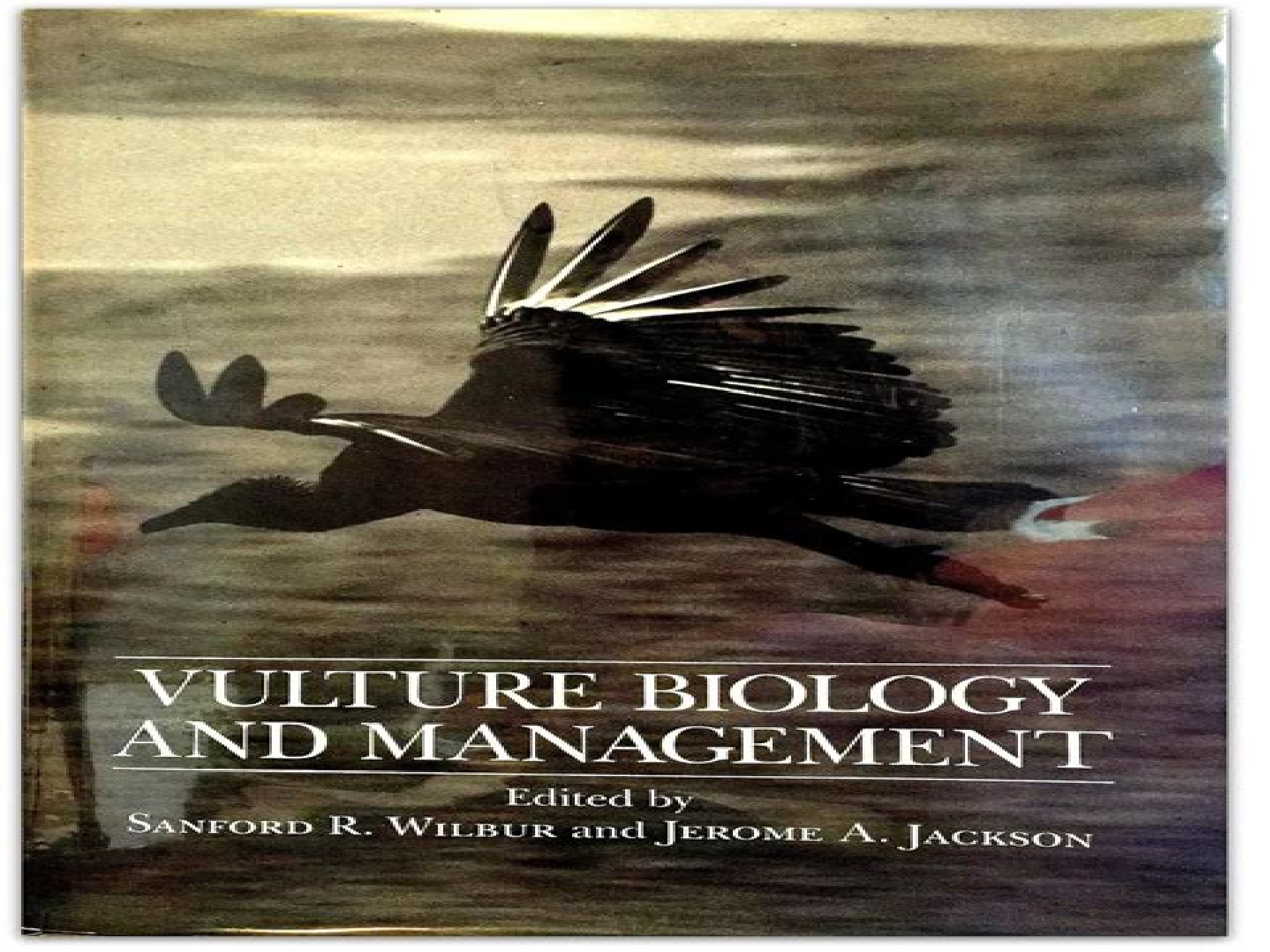

Simply because they are large scavenging birds vultures are often viewed as harbingers of death But as Thom van Dooren shows in this cultural and natural history that dominant association leaves us with a very one dimensional understanding of a group of actually rather fascinating and diverse creatures Vulture offers an enlightening new history of this much misunderstood bird Vultures vary in type and size and while some have a diet mainly of bone others are actually almost completely vegetarian Most interesting despite its notorious association with death the vulture very rarely if ever kills for itself In different cultural mythologies vultures play a role in disposing of the dead and officiating over human sacrifices but they have often been viewed as courageous and noble creatures as well believed to be indispensable in the containment of waste and disease and even to be world creators and divine mothers Van Dooren explores these many histories from some of the earliest known Neolithic sites in which vultures are thought to have consumed the dead to contemporary efforts to reintroduce the bearded vulture into the Alps Highlighting the rich diversity of vultures and the many ways in which people have understood and lived with them Vulture invites a new appreciation and wonder for these incredible birds **Vultures** Michael O'Neal Campbell, 2015-06-26 This book reexamines current knowledge on the evolution ecology and conservation biology of both New World vultures Cathartidae and Old World vultures Accipitridae and seeks answers to past and present regional extinctions colorizations and conservation questions Extinct species of both families are examined as is the disputed evidence for *The Birds of British Columbia* Robert Wayne Campbell, Canadian Wildlife Service, British Columbia. Raptors of New Mexico Jean-Luc E. Cartron, 2010-08-16 No book has ever before specifically focused on the birds of prey of New Mexico Both Florence Bailey 1928 and J Stokley Ligon 1961 published volumes on the birds of New Mexico but their coverage of raptors was somewhat limited In the ensuing years a great deal of new information has been collected on these mighty hunters distribution ecology and conservation including in New Mexico The book begins with a history of the word raptor The order of Raptatores or Raptores was first used to classify birds of prey in the early nineteenth century derived from the Latin word raptor one who seizes by force The text then includes the writings of thirty seven contributing authors who relate their observations on these regal species For example Joe Truett recounts the following in the chapter on the Swainson s Hawk From spring to fall each year at the Jornada Caves in the Jornada del Muerto Swainson s hawks assemble daily to catch bats The bats exit the caves actually lava tubes near sundown The hawks swoop in snatch bats from the air and eat them on the wing Originally from France Jean Luc Cartron has lived and worked on several continents finding his passion in the wide open spaces of New Mexico He became fascinated by the birds of prey and has studied their ecology and conservation for nearly twenty years Raptors of New Mexico will provide readers with a comprehensive treatment of all hawks eagles kites vultures falcons and owls breeding or wintering in New Mexico or simply migrating through the state This landmark study is also beautifully illustrated with more than six hundred photographs including the work of more than one hundred photographers and more than twenty species distribution maps

Birds of Ontario: Habitat Requirements, Limiting Factors, and Status Al Sandilands, 2011-01-01 The vast literature on the history of birds is continually growing but rarely has this information been compiled so that it is readily available in one reference work Birds of Ontario is such a work providing a comprehensive summary of the life history requirements of bird species in the province In the first volume information on habitat limiting factors and status is presented for 84 species of nonpasserines that occur regularly in Ontario These topics are covered for the three primary avian seasons breeding migration and winter A wealth of information including habitat nest sites territoriality site fidelity annual reproductive effort habitat loss and degradation and environmental contaminants are covered in the species accounts The book is greatly enhanced by illustrations by Ross James Maps depicting breeding and wintering range are also presented for each species Birds of Ontario will be an essential reference for wildlife biologists environmental consultants and planners preparing or reviewing environmental impact statements and environmental assessments Serious birders will find it of interest as well Although the book focuses on
