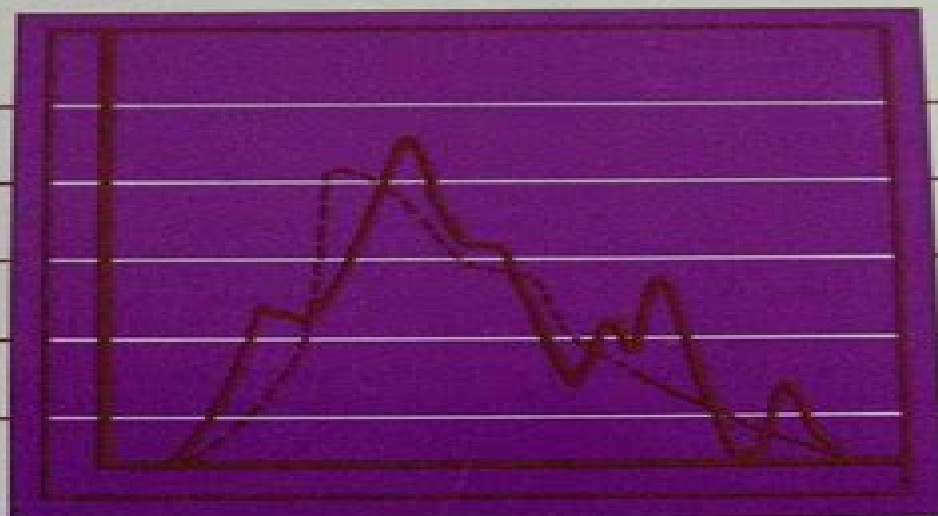

Brady, David Collier, 2008 Political methodology has changed dramatically over the past thirty years and many new methods and techniques have been developed Both the Political Methodology Society and the Qualitative Multi Methods Section of the American Political Science Association have engaged in ongoing research and training programs that have advanced quantitative and qualitative methodology The Oxford Handbook of Political Methodology presents and synthesizes these developments The Handbook provides comprehensive overviews of diverse methodological approaches with an emphasis on three major themes First specific methodological tools should be at the service of improved conceptualization comprehension of meaning measurement and data collection They should increase analysts leverage in reasoning about causal relationships and evaluating them empirically by contributing to powerful research designs Second the authors explore the many different ways of addressing these tasks through case studies and large n designs with both quantitative and qualitative data and via techniques ranging from statistical modelling to process tracing Finally techniques can cut across traditional methodological boundaries and can be useful for many different kinds of researchers Many of the authors thus explore how their methods can inform and be used by scholars engaged in diverse branches of methodology The Indirect Effect of Direct Legislation Frederick J. Boehmke, 2005 To demonstrate this the author models the incentives that the initiative process creates for interests to organize and for how they communicate their preferences to policy makers Interests that represent a broader range of the public are found to gain the most from the option to propose initiatives implying that the set of organized interests in initiative states should reflect this advantage Ironically an effect of direct legislation is to potentially increase the effectiveness of special interest lobbying in state legislatures in a sense the opposite of the direct control that gives direct legislation its theoretical appeal Yet the clear effect is one of empowering voices that traditionally had very little effect in the legislative process **Altering Party Systems** Simon Hug, 2010-05-06 New political parties have regularly appeared in developed democracies around the world In some countries issues focusing on the environment immigration economic decline and regional concerns have been brought to the forefront by new political parties In other countries these issues have been addressed by established parties and new issue driven parties have failed to form Most current research is unable to explain why under certain circumstances new issues or neglected old ones lead to the formation of new parties Based on a novel theoretical framework this study demonstrates the crucial interplay between established parties and possible newcomers to explain the emergence of new political parties Deriving stable hypotheses from a simple theoretical model the book proceeds to a study of party formation

in twenty two developed democracies New or neglected issues still appear as a driving force in explaining the emergence of new parties but their effect is partially mediated by institutional factors such as access to the ballot public support for parties and the electoral system The hypotheses in part support existing theoretical work but in part present new insights The theoretical model also pinpoints problems of research design that are hardly addressed in the comparative literature on new political parties These insights from the theoretical model lead to empirical tests that improve on those employed in the literature and allow for a much enhanced understanding of the formation and the success of new parties Simon Hug is Lecturer in Political Science University of Geneva

The Politics of Repression Under Authoritarian Rule Dag Tanneberg, 2020-01-03 Does authoritarian rule benefit from political repression This book claims that it does if restrictions and violence two fundamentally different forms of repression complement each other Based on an in depth quantitative analysis of the post Second World War period the author draws three central conclusions Firstly restrictions and violence offer different advantages suffer from different drawbacks and matter differently for identical problems of authoritarian rule Secondly empirical data supports complementarity only as long as political repression preempts political opposition Lastly despite its conceptual centrality political repression has little influence on the outcomes of authoritarian politics The book also offers new insights into questions such as whether repression hinders successful political campaigns or whether it is more likely to trigger coups d tat

Regression Models for Categorical and Limited Dependent Variables J. Scott Long, 1997-01-09 THE APPROACH J Scott Long s approach is one that I highly commend There is a decided emphasis on the application and interpretation of the specific statistical techniques Long works from the premise that the major difficulty with the analysis of limited and categorical dependent variables LCDVs is the complexity of interpreting nonlinear models and he provides tools for interpretation that can be widely applied across the different

can practice the techniques as they read about them **Cyber Persistence Theory** Michael P. Fischerkeller, Emily O. Goldman, Richard J. Harknett, 2022 A bold re conceptualization of the fundamentals driving behavior and dynamics in cyberspace Most cyber operations and campaigns fall short of activities that states would regard as armed conflict In Cyber Persistence Theory Michael P Fischerkeller Emily O Goldman and Richard J Harknett argue that a failure to understand this strategic competitive space has led many states to misapply the logic and strategies of coercion and conflict to this environment and thus suffer strategic loss as a result The authors show how the paradigm of deterrence theory can neither explain nor manage the preponderance of state cyber activity They present a new theory that illuminates the exploitive rather than coercive dynamics of cyber competition and an analytical framework that can serve as the basis for new strategies of persistence Drawing on their policy experience they offer a new set of prescriptions to guide policymakers toward a more stable secure cyberspace

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
