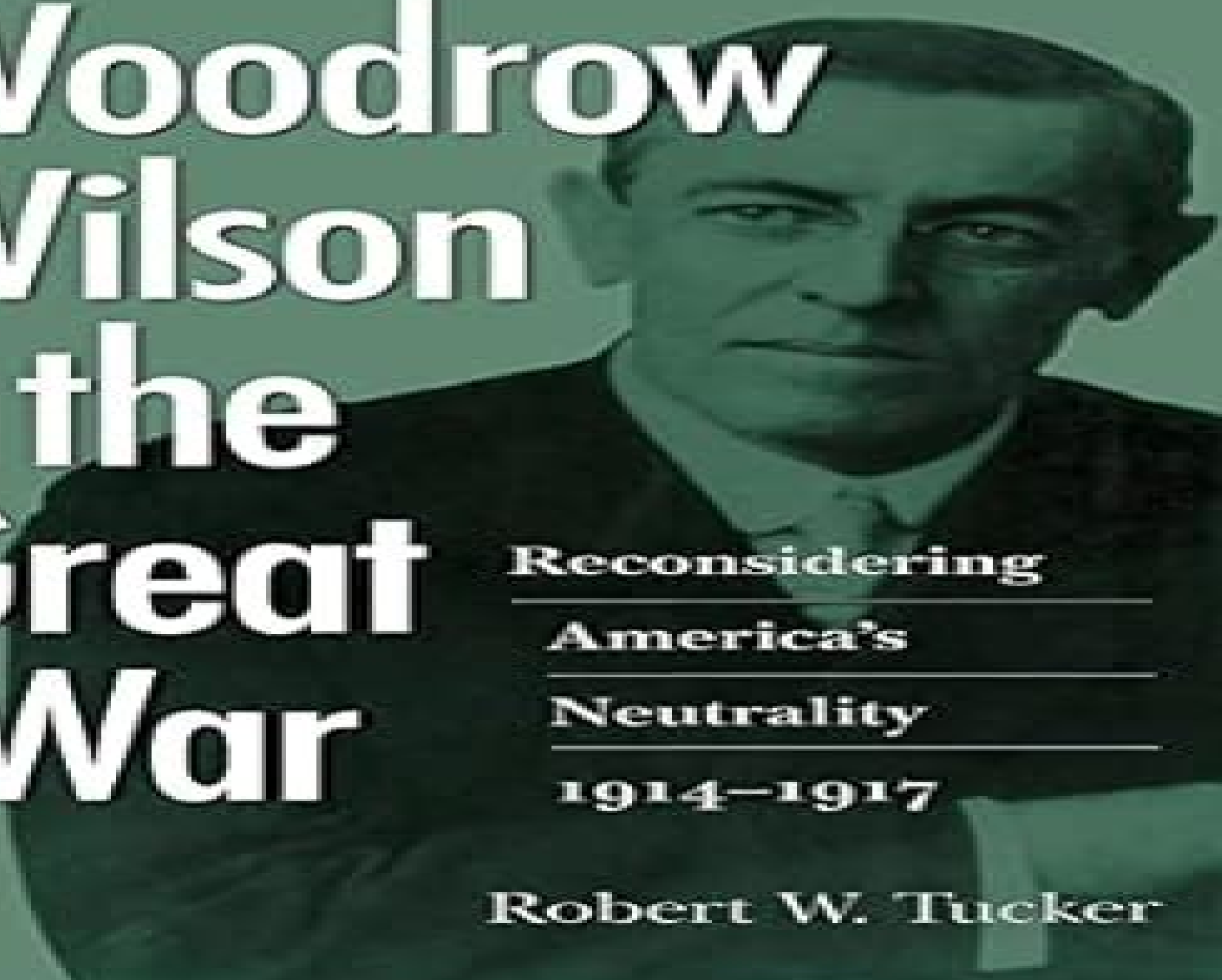

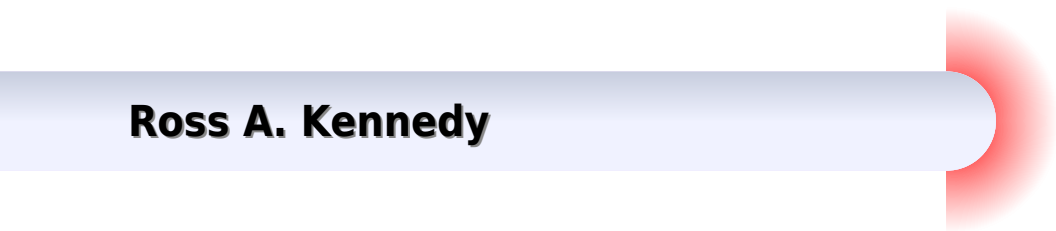

Tucker, 2007 In recent years and in light of U S attempts to project power in the world the presidency of Woodrow Wilson has been more commonly invoked than ever before Yet Wilsonianism has often been distorted by a concentration on American involvement in the First World War In *Woodrow Wilson and the Great War Reconsidering America's Neutrality 1914 1917* prominent scholar Robert Tucker turns the focus to the years of neutrality Arguing that our neglect of this prewar period has reduced the complexity of the historical Wilson to a caricature or stereotype Tucker reveals the importance that the law of neutrality played in Wilson's foreign policy during the fateful years from 1914 to 1917 and in doing so he provides a more complete portrait of our nation's twenty eighth president By focusing on the years leading up to America's involvement in the Great War Tucker reveals that Wilson's internationalism was always highly qualified dependent from the start upon the advent of an international order that would forever remove the specter of another major war World War I was the last conflict in which the law of neutrality played an important role in the calculations of belligerents and neutrals and it is scarcely an exaggeration to say that this law or rather Woodrow Wilson's version of it constituted almost the whole of his foreign policy with regard to the war Wilson's refusal to find any significance moral or otherwise in the conflict beyond the law and its violation led him to see the war as meaningless save for the immense suffering and sense of utter futility it fostered Treating issues of enduring interest such as the advisability and effectiveness of U S interventions in or initiation of conflicts beyond its borders *Woodrow Wilson and the Great War* will appeal to anyone interested in the president's power to determine foreign policy and in constitutional history in general

future In her book Hilde Eliassen Restad challenges this assumption arguing that U S history has displayed a remarkably constant foreign policy tradition which she labels unilateral internationalism The United States Restad argues has not vacillated between an exemplary and a missionary identity Instead the United States developed an exceptionalist identity that while idealizing the United States as an exemplary city upon a hill more often than not errs on the side of the missionary crusade in its foreign policy Utilizing the latest historiography in the study of U S foreign relations the book updates political science scholarship and sheds new light on the role American exceptionalism has played and continues to play in shaping America s role in the world This work will be of great interest to students and scholars of US foreign policy security studies and American politics

Benjamin Allen Coates, 2016-06-01 America s empire expanded dramatically following the Spanish American War of 1898 The United States quickly annexed the Philippines and Puerto Rico seized control over Cuba and the Panama Canal Zone and extended political and financial power throughout Latin America This age of empire Benjamin Allen Coates argues was also an age of international law Justifying America s empire with the language of law and civilization international lawyers serving

simultaneously as academics leaders of the legal profession corporate attorneys and high ranking government officials became central to the conceptualization conduct and rationalization of US foreign policy Just as international law shaped empire so too did empire shape international law Legalist Empire shows how the American Society of International Law was animated by the same notions of civilization that justified the expansion of empire overseas Using the private papers and published writings of such figures as Elihu Root John Bassett Moore and James Brown Scott Coates shows how the newly created international law profession merged European influences with trends in American jurisprudence while appealing to elite notions of order reform and American identity By projecting an image of the United States as a unique force for law and civilization legalists reconciled American exceptionalism empire and an international rule of law Under their influence the nation became the world s leading advocate for the creation of an international court Although the legalist vision of world peace through voluntary adjudication foundered in the interwar period international lawyers through their ideas and their presence in halls of power continue to infuse vital debates about America s global role

Thompson, 2015-12-04 Why has the United States assumed so extensive and costly a role in world affairs over the last hundred years The two most common answers to this question are because it could and because it had to Neither answer will do according to this challenging re assessment of the way that America came to assume its global role The country s vast economic resources gave it the capacity to exercise great influence abroad but Americans were long reluctant to meet the costs of wielding that power Neither the country s safety from foreign attack nor its economic well being required the achievement of ambitious foreign policy objectives In *A Sense of Power* John A Thompson takes a long view of America s dramatic rise as a world power from the late nineteenth century into the post World War II era How and more importantly why has America come to play such a dominant role in world affairs There is he argues no simple answer Thompson challenges conventional explanations of America s involvement in World War

I and World War II seeing neither the requirements of national security nor economic interests as determining He shows how American leaders from Wilson to Truman developed an ever more capacious understanding of the national interest and why by the 1940s most Americans came to support the price tag in blood and treasure attached to strenuous efforts to shape the world The beliefs and emotions that led them to do so reflected distinctive aspects of U S culture not least the strength of ties to Europe Consciousness of the nation s unique power fostered feelings of responsibility entitlement and aspiration among the people and leaders of the United States This original analysis challenges some widely held beliefs about the determinants of United States foreign policy and will bring new insight to contemporary debates about whether the nation should or must play so active a part in world politics

Texas and Texans in the Great War Ralph A. Wooster, 2009 The outbreak of war in Europe in the summer of 1914 surprised Americans Although most hoped to avoid involvement in the conflict the German submarine campaign against shipping in the north Atlantic brought the United States into the war in April 1917 as an ally of the British French Italians and Russians Before World War I ended in November 1918 the United States mobilized over four million men and suffered over 350 000 casualties including 120 000 who were killed in action or died from disease 200 000 Texans served in the American armed forces during what contemporaries called the Great War Over 5 000 Texans in uniform died during the conflict Four Texans were awarded the Medal of Honor for gallantry in action Several Texans received the Distinguished Service Cross the Distinguished Service Medal or the French Croix de Guerre Three qualified as aces by shooting down five enemy aircraft Military historian Ralph A. Wooster describes the role Texans played in the war both overseas in the major battles and campaigns and on the home front producing the materials needed to carry on a modern war He shows that the mobilization of the mind and spirit during the war kindled the growth of patriotism and brought Texans into the mainstream of American life for the first time since the American Civil War
