So how exactly does tourism contribute to narrowing this glaring inequality between the rich and poor? Are ever expanding tourism markets a smoke-free socioculturally sensitive form of human industrialisation? Is alternative tourism really a credible lever for reducing global inequality and eliminating poverty? Tourism and Sustainability critically explores the most significant universal geopolitical norms of the last half century: development, globalisation and sustainability, and through the lens of new forms of tourism demonstrates how we can better get to grips with the rapidly changing new global order.
