






violence shelters The purpose of the study was to validate the Trauma Assessment for Young Children The Trauma Assessment for Young Children had good test retest reliability The measure was found to have moderate internal consistency on both the child report and caregiver report versions with higher levels in the caregiver report The Trauma Assessment for Young Children had good convergent validity with the with the Trauma Symptom Checklist for Young Children's PTSD subscale It demonstrated good discriminant validity with the Child Behavior Checklist's externalizing subscales attention aggression and total externalizing Finally the Trauma Assessment for Young Children demonstrated known groups validity on the caregiver report version of the measure indicating that it has the ability to differentiate between the children who have and have not experienced trauma These results are promising for the future utility of the measure with children who have experienced a trauma however the sample size was small therefore implications for future research are discussed as well as implications for social work policy and practice
