Lanktree, 2012 Bad Blood reveals that Bastille is a synth driven band that isn't particularly arty something of a rarity during the electronic pop revival of the 2000s and 2010s Where many of their contemporaries used the glamour of synth pop's 80s heyday and electronic music's infinite possibilities to craft shiny pop fantasies Bastille builds on the glossy anthemic approach they set forth on the Laura Palmer EP the title track which is included here might also be the least arty song inspired by David Lynch's surreal soap opera Twin Peaks Early highlights like Pompeii These Streets and the title track boast panoramic choruses and sleek arrangements that hint at a kinship with Empire of the Sun and Delphic while the handclaps and popping bassline on the otherwise moody Icarus recall Hot Chip at their most confessional However most of Bad Blood suggests that Bastille are actually an electronically enhanced upgrade of sweeping British pop traditionalists like Keane or Coldplay The band updates Oblivion's piano balladry with ping ponging drums and contrasts Dan Smith's throaty singing and searching lyrics There's a hole in my soul Can you fill it with a tumbling beat on Flaws Like the aforementioned acts Bastille has a way with heartfelt melodies and choruses that resonate particularly on the driving Things We Lost in the Fire and Get Home where the slightly processed vocals also evoke Sia Imogen Heap and other electronic friendly singer songwriters While the band occasionally gets a little too self serious on the album's second half Bad Blood is a solid polished debut that fans of acts like Snow Patrol who don't mind more electronics in the mix might appreciate more than synth pop aficionados Heather Phares Pediatric Neuropsychiatry Aaron J. Hauptman, Jay A. Salpekar, 2018-10-26 Adult neuropsychiatry is now a well established field with numerous reputable references Practitioners who work with children routinely note how references and practitioners knowledgeable in the equivalent work in the pediatric world are rare Child psychiatrists and neurologists frequently work with individuals struggling with these conditions and would strongly benefit from such a reference that incorporates medical work up psychopharmacological recommendations family support

recommendations and theoretical pathophysiology Pediatricians and developmental pediatricians often treat children with behavioral and neuropsychiatric sequelae but are not well trained in the neuropsychiatric management of these cases Neuropsychologists and educational psychologists working with children and adults with pediatric onset conditions will also find the text helpful to contextualize their cases better understand the medical evaluation and management and perhaps adjust recommendations that would supplement their own testing methods Finally sub specialists in adult neurology psychiatry and neuropsychiatry often find themselves working with these children by default as there are few pediatric subspecialists who are available to accept them into practice When facing complex neuropsychiatric illness in children many clinicians are stymied because they may have never seen a case like that This text fills the wide gap that currently exists and helps move this field forward The approach utilized in adult neuropsychiatry that is both clear and accessible does not yet have an equivalent in the pediatric realm but there is tremendous interest in its development Children and adolescents with neuropsychiatric conditions are very common and they and their caregivers often struggle to find professionals well educated in this field Ultimately a wide range of clinicians will find this text to be a very helpful resource for diagnosis and management in the spectrum of pediatric neuropsychiatric conditions The case based approach is also unique with respect to neuropsychiatric approaches and the clear cut reader friendly approach of such a format would likely be well received among physicians looking for a resource on this issue

Assessment of Trauma in Youths Kathleen Nader, 2016-05-06 Assessment of Trauma in Youths Understanding issues of age complexity and associated variables is a collection of articles by well known specialists in the field of childhood trauma The articles describe developmental issues in addition to others that are important to the assessment of trauma exposed youth to the ongoing refinement of trauma related diagnoses for children and to understanding PTSD and more complicated reactions to trauma for young people The book explores trauma in very young to middle childhood aged children trauma in adolescents childhood complicated trauma and childhood complicated grief It considers PTSD and Reactive Attachment Disorder as well as discussing disorders that are under continued study such as Developmental Trauma Disorder Prolonged Grief Disorder and Traumatic Grief In the second half of the book chapters look at the associated features of childhood traumatic response such as genetics and personality cortisol poly victimization and guilt and shame Variables such as cortisol reactivity and guilt shame may influence or follow traumas in children This book was originally published as a special issue of the Journal of Child and Adolescent Trauma

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
