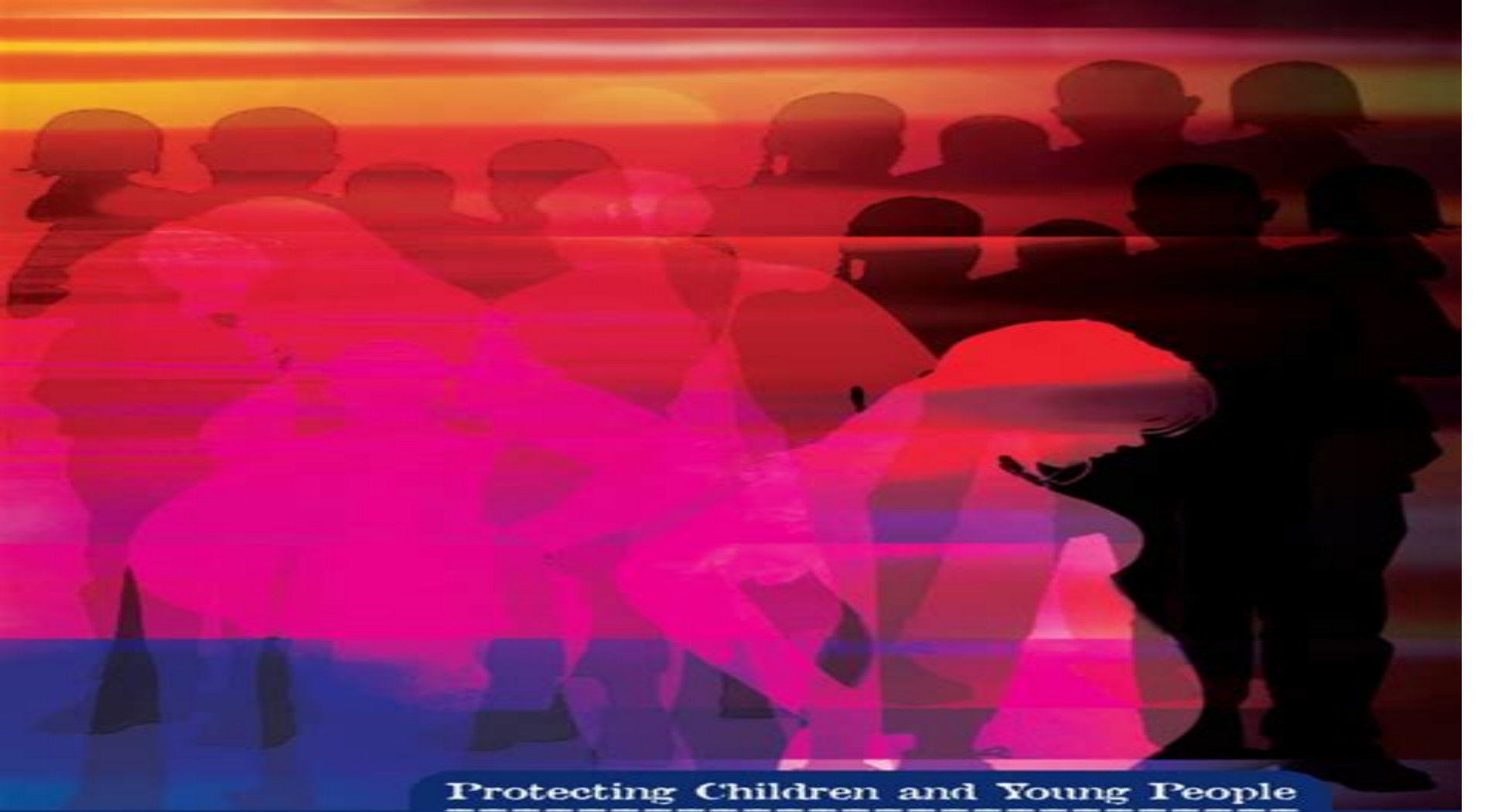

all family members by parental mental and or substance use disorders is great Fortunately the opportunities to intervene are plentiful and varied However in many cases interventions are unspecified untested and not brought to scale in regional state or national initiatives We may have the requisite knowledge to inform policy and practice but this evidence may not be applied to effect innovation or change suggesting the need for widespread knowledge translation and dissemination efforts with significant potential to improve public mental health
