subject there are many other books that will serve you better than this one Treating venture capital as a topic of finance overemphasizes the importance of numbers For VCs number play a large role but just as important is the story about the numbers In this regard I will argue that VCs are more like journalists and filmmakers than financiers What I have not been able to find is a holistic overview of venture capital as a topic of strategy explaining its place in the broader entrepreneurial ecosystem It is not simply entrepreneurial finance VCs play a very important strategic role in commercializing technologies Just as importantly they employ specific strategies that we can learn and apply to our own entrepreneurial circumstances
