**Theological Aesthetics** Richard Viladesau, 1999-03-25 This book explores the role of aesthetic experience in our perception and understanding of the holy Richard Viladesau's goal is to articulate a theology of revelation examined in relation to three principal dimensions of the aesthetic realm feeling and imagination beauty or taste and the arts After briefly considering ways in which theology itself can be imaginative or beautiful Viladesau concentrates on the theological significance of aesthetic data provided by each of the three major spheres of aesthetic perception and response Throughout the work the underlying question is how each of these spheres serves as a source however ambiguous of revelation Although he frames much of his argument in terms of Catholic theology from the Church Fathers to Karl Rahner Hans Urs von Balthasar Bernard Lonergan and David Tracy Viladesau also makes extensive use of ideas from the Protestant theologian of the arts Gerardus van der Leeuw and draws insights from such diverse thinkers as Hans Goerg Gadamer Wolfhart Pannenberg and Iris Murdoch His analysis is enlivened by the artistic examples he selects the music of Mozart as contemplated by Karl Barth Schoenberg's opera *Moses und Aron* the sculptures of Chartres Cathedral poems by Rilke and Michelangelo and many others What emerges from this study is what Viladesau terms a transcendental theology of aesthetics In Thomistic terms he finds that beauty is not only a perfection but a transcendental That is any instance of beauty rightly perceived and rightly understood can be seen to imply divinely beautiful things as well In other words Viladesau argues God is the absolute and necessary condition for the possibility of beauty

**Theological Aesthetics** Richard Viladesau, 1999 In this book Richard Viladesau construes Christian theology as a theological aesthetics He examines Christian revelation and its presuppositions in relationship to three interconnected meanings of the aesthetic in modern thought human cognition as feeling and imagination the realm of the beautiful and the arts

*Spirit and Beauty* Patrick Sherry, 1992 Many Christian theologians have associated

beauty both in nature and art with the Holy Spirit They include early Fathers like St Irenaeus and St Clement of Alexandria and later writers like Calvin Jonathan Edwards Sergius Bulgakov and Hans von Balthasar An exploration of early thought on the topic this book is an introduction to theological aesthetics Besides examining the connection made between the Holy Spirit and beauty Sherry expands on the theme by considering related topics such as divine glory inspiration and the eschatological character of beauty He effectively brings together two areas of lively interest in contemporary Christianity the theology of the Holy Spirit and theological aesthetics

Garrett, 2013-07-24 Jurgen Moltmann and others contend that Christian theology and the church face a dual crisis one of relevance and the other of identity Despite making this pronouncement nearly forty years ago the church in the West continues to struggle with this crisis Several proposals have been espoused from the way of wisdom to the way of ecclesial praxis Yet little attention is given in Protestant theological discourse to the role God's beauty plays in bringing theology and ethics together By neglecting God's beauty for theological discourse we risk diminishing Christian worship witness and wisdom God's Beauty in Act addresses these issues in part by arguing that the redemptive creative suffering and glorious resurrection of Christ are the nexus of God's being beauty and Christian living God's beauty understood as the fittingness of the incarnate Son's actions in the Spirit to the Father's will radiates God's glory and draws perceivers into the dramatic movements of God's triune life These movements serve as the patterns that shape the imagination enabling participants to perform their parts creatively and fittingly in God's drama of redemption In doing so human beings flourish as they jettison false identities and realities of their own making that are incommensurate with God's purpose found in Christ by the Spirit
