A Woven Silence Felicity Hayes-McCoy, 2015-09-01 How do we know that what we remember is the truth Inspired by the story of her relative Marion Stokes one of three women who raised the tricolour over Enniscorthy in Easter Week 1916 Felicity Hayes McCoy explores the consequences for all of us when memories are manipulated or obliterated intentionally or by chance In the power struggle after the Easter Rising involving among others Michael Collins and Eamon de Valera the ideals for which Marion and her companions fought were eroded resulting in an Ireland marked by chauvinism isolationism and secrecy By mapping her own family stories onto the history of the State Felicity examines how Irish life today has been affected by the censorship and mixed messages of the past Absorbing entertaining and touching her story moves from Washerwoman's Hill in Dublin to London and back again spans two world wars a revolution a civil war and the development of a republic and culminates in Ireland's 2015 same sex marriage referendum Also by this author Enough is Plenty A Woven Silence Felicity Hayes-McCoy, 2016 *Single Mothers in Twentieth-century Ireland and Britain* Lorraine Grimes, 2025-08-21 Throughout the Twentieth Century many women in Ireland and Britain endured shame and institutionalisation for becoming pregnant outside of marriage In this welcome study Lorraine Grimes examines the journeys made by hundreds of pregnant Irish women to Britain as they fled to escape their local communities Their experiences in Britain however were not free of stigma and Grimes's book analyses the nuances of the institutional networks both in Britain and Ireland which these women utilised *Single Mothers in Twentieth Century Ireland and Britain* focuses on the experiences of women from 1926-1973 in cities with high Irish emigrant populations including London Liverpool Birmingham and Glasgow Unlike official narratives such as Ireland's Commission of Investigation into the Mother and Baby Homes this book prioritises the experiences of the survivors and ensure that women's experiences are central to the narrative It also incorporates original interviews with children born in institutions and for the first time interviews with religious and medical staff are also included in the historiography Using archival research and oral history Grimes reveals the methods British and Irish institutions developed from forced adoption to repatriation and the impacts of this on the women and children's lives Grimes makes a significant contribution to the historiography surrounding the movement of women and children across international borders through repatriation and adoption between institutions on both sides of the Irish Sea From extensive archival research this book reveals cases of Irish single mothers seeking assistance in Britain as well as cases of rape incest and domestic violence within the institutional records In addition archival cases expose prejudice towards women from other colonial countries in institutions in Britain particularly from the 1960s A first for the field *Single Mothers* includes a chapter on the experiences of single fathers Sensitive to the underlying issues of class and gender politics the book also shows that women often enacted a large degree of agency to improve their situation If you are interested in women's political and social history and the history of the institutional relationships of Britain and Ireland this book is essential reading **Between**

Communities of Memory William James Booth, 2018-07-05 Memory has fueled merciless violent strife and it has been at the core of reconciliation and reconstruction It has been used to justify great crimes and yet it is central to the pursuit of justice In these and more everyday ways we live surrounded by memory individual and social in our habits our names the places where we live street names libraries archives and our citizenship institutions and laws Still we wonder what to make of memory and its gifts though sometimes we are hardly even certain that they are gifts Of the many chambers in this vast palace I mean to ask particularly after the place of memory in politics in the identity of political communities and in their practices of doing justice from the Preface W James Booth seeks to understand the place of memory in the identity ethics and practices of justice of political communities Identity is he believes a particular kind of continuity across time one central to the possibility of agency and responsibility and memory plays a central role in grounding that continuity Memory identity takes two forms a habitlike form the deep presence of the past that is part of a life led in common and a more fragile vulnerable form in which memory struggles to preserve identity through time notably in bearing witness a form of memory work deeply bound up with the identity of political communities Booth argues that memory holds a defining place in determining how justice is administered Memory is tied to the very possibility of an ethical

community one responsible for its own past able to make commitments for the future and driven to seek justice Underneath and motivating the politics of memory understood as contests over the writing of history over memorials museums and canons he writes there lies an intertwining of memory identity and justice Communities of Memory both argues for and maps out that intertwining

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
