the work of Afro Cuban and Puerto Rican writer Piri Thomas to think about the crucial role that violence against minority communities plays in the creation of self identity Her final chapter considers the place of secrecy and spirituality in the work of mostly but not solely Afro Latina writers to recenter how the valuing of domesticity and spirituality can push back against the way their lives are marginalized to create their own Afro Latina feminisms Theatre and Revolution Logan J.
