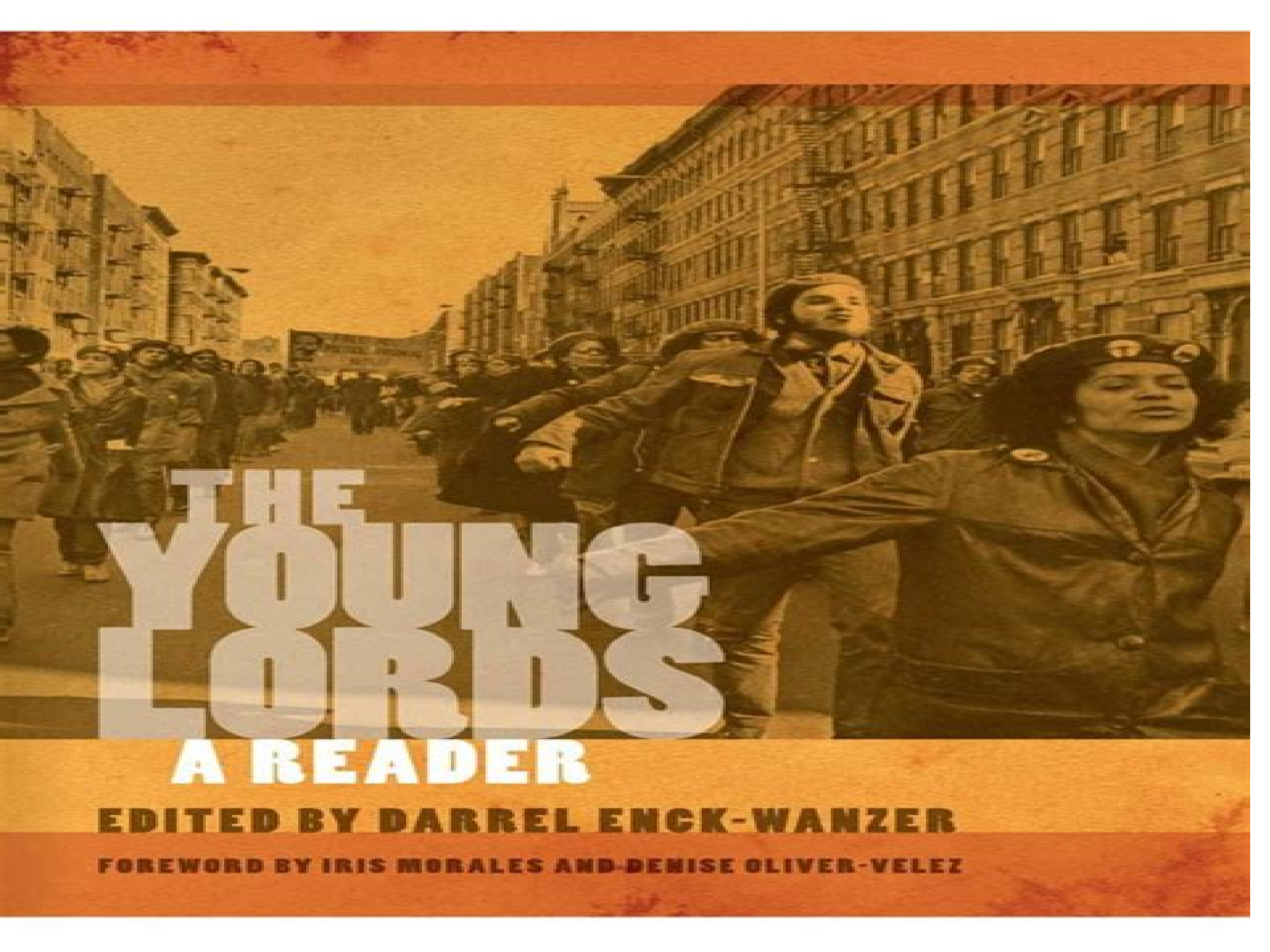

The Young Lords Darrel Enck-Wanzer, 2010-11-03 The Young Lords who originated as a Chicago street gang fighting gentrification and unfair evictions in Puerto Rican neighborhoods burgeoned into a national political movement in the late 1960s and early 1970s with headquarters in New York City and other centers in Philadelphia Boston Los Angeles and elsewhere in the northeast and southern California Part of the original Rainbow Coalition with the Black Panthers and Young Patriots the politically radical Puerto Ricans who constituted the Young Lords instituted programs for political social and cultural change within the communities in which they operated The Young Lords offers readers the opportunity to learn about this vibrant organization through their own words and images collecting an array of their essays journalism photographs speeches and pamphlets Organized topically and thematically this volume highlights the Young Lords diverse and inventive activism around issues such as education health care gentrification police injustice and gender equality as well as self determination for Puerto Rico In recovering these rare written and visual materials Darrel Enck Wanzer has given voice to the lost chorus of the Young Lords while providing an indispensable resource for students scholars activists and others interested in learning about this influential grassroots street political organization

A Woman's Life Is a Human Life Felicia Kornbluh, 2023-01-17 Published to coincide with the fiftieth anniversary of Roe v Wade this urgent book from historian Felicia Kornbluh reveals two movement victories in New York that forever changed the politics of reproductive rights nationally Before there was a Jane Roe the most important champions of reproductive rights were ordinary people working in their local communities In A Woman's Life Is a Human Life historian Felicia Kornbluh delivers the untold story of everyday activists who defined those rights and achieved them in the years immediately before and after Roe v Wade made abortion legal under federal law A Woman's Life Is a Human Life is the story of two movements in New York that transformed the politics of reproductive rights the fight to decriminalize abortion and the fight against sterilization abuse which happened disproportionately in communities of color and was central to an activism that was about the right to bear children as well as not to Each initiative won key victories that relied on people power and not on the federal courts Their histories cast new light on Roe and constitutional rights on the difficulty and importance of achieving a truly inclusive feminism and on reproductive politics today This is a book full of drama From dissident Democrats who were the first to try reforming abortion laws and members of a rising feminist movement who refashioned them to the nation's largest abortion referral service established by progressive Christian and Jewish clergy to Puerto Rican activists who demanded community accountability in healthcare and introduced sterilization abuse to the movement's agenda and Black women who took the cause global A Woman's Life Is a Human Life documents the diverse ways activists changed the law and worked to create a world that would support all people's reproductive choices The first in depth study of a winning campaign against a state's abortion law and the first to chronicle the sterilization abuse fight side by side with the one for abortion rights A Woman's

Life Is a Human Life is rich with firsthand accounts and previously unseen sources including those from Kornbluh's mother who wrote the first draft of New York's law decriminalizing abortion and their across the hall neighbor Dr Helen Rodríguez Trías as a Puerto Rican doctor who cofounded the movement against sterilization abuse In this dynamic surprising and highly readable history Felicia Kornbluh corrects the record to show how grassroots action overcame the odds to create policy change and how it might work today The New York Young Lords and the Struggle for Liberation Darrel

Wanzer-Serrano, 2015-06-12 The Young Lords was a multi ethnic though primarily Nuyorican liberation organization that formed in El Barrio Spanish Harlem in July of 1969 Responding to oppressive approaches to the health educational and political needs of the Puerto Rican community the movement's revolutionary activism included organized protests and sit ins targeting such concerns as trash pickups and lead paint hazards The Young Lords advanced a thirteen point political program that demanded community control of their institutions and land and challenged the exercise of power by the state and outsider run institutions In The New York Young Lords and the Struggle for Liberation Darrel Wanzer Serrano details the numerous community initiatives that advanced decolonial sensibilities in El Barrio and beyond Using archival research and interviews he crafts an engaging account of the Young Lords discourse and activism He rescues the organization from historical obscurity and makes an argument for its continued relevance enriching and informing contemporary discussions about Latino a politics Invisibility and Influence Regina Marie Mills, 2024-06-04 Invisibility and Influence is the first study of writings depicting Afro Latinx life in the US and the Hispanophone Caribbean It demonstrates how a century's worth of Afro Latinx writers in both places helped shape life writing including autobiography memoir collective autobiography and other formats Mills's work explores the tensions these writers experienced in being viewed by others as only either Latinx or Black not as a distinctive community that embodies both and should not be seen as simply a bridge between them This is not only a story of this specific and overlooked community but is also a history of how its work shaped and complicated discourses on race and colorism in the western hemisphere In doing so these writers created a literary history of themselves within the broader literary history of the Americas The first chapter looks at the life writings of Arturo Arthur Schomburg a writer who collected and recovered the voices of lost writers of the African Diaspora such as Phyllis Wheatley His collections of papers and art eventually created the core archive for the Schomburg Center for Research in Black Culture Mills elucidates his own writings of his life in Harlem and shows how they were in deeper conversation with Ralph Waldo Emerson and Thomas Carlyle's writings that had shaped a white American tradition of autobiography as well as with Black autobiographical writers such as W E B DuBois She extends the ties of Schomburg's Afro Puerto Rican background and life writings to Jesus Colón's sketches in the 1920s and even further to self depictions by members of The Young Lords through multiple medias such as photography film and poetry She is particularly interested in the ways that The Young Lords created a model of observe and participate that permeates all of their activities from recruitment to writing among others She uses

the work of Afro Cuban and Puerto Rican writer Piri Thomas to think about the crucial role that violence against minority communities plays in the creation of self identity Her final chapter considers the place of secrecy and spirituality in the work of mostly but not solely Afro Latina writers to re center how the valuing of domesticity and spirituality can push back against the way their lives are marginalized to create their own Afro Latina feminisms *Theatre and Revolution* Logan J.
