Theft of an Idol Paul R. Brass, 2020-09-01 As collective violence erupts in many regions throughout the world we often hear media reports that link the outbreaks to age old ethnic or religious hostilities thereby freeing the state its agents and its political elites from responsibility Paul Brass encourages us to look more closely at the issues of violence ethnicity and the state by focusing on specific instances of violence in their local contexts and questioning the prevailing interpretations of them Through five case studies of both rural and urban public violence including police public confrontations and Hindu Muslim riots Brass shows how out of many possible interpretations applicable to these incidents government and the media select those that support existing relations of power in state and society Adopting different modes narrator detective and social scientist Brass treats incidents of collective violence arising initially out of common occurrences such as a drunken brawl the rape of a girl and the theft of an idol and demonstrates how some incidents remain localized while others are fit into broader frameworks of meaning thereby becoming useful for upholders of dominant ideologies Incessant talk about violence and its implications in these circumstances contributes to its persistence rather than its reduction Such treatment serves in fact to mask the causes of violence displace the victims from the center of attention and divert society's gaze from those responsible for its endemic character Brass explains how this process ultimately implicates everyone in the perpetuation of systems of violence

Murder in the Bylanes Alok Lal, Maanas Lal, 2022-02-15 UNPUTDOWNABLE Tehelka Keeping the peace in a time of chaos Uttar Pradesh in the aftermath of the Babri Masjid demolition was a state on edge When Alok Lal took over as the Deputy Inspector General of Kanpur the congratulations came with a warning to move with caution as Kanpur was then the most volatile city in north India In *Murder in the Bylanes* Lal recounts his time policing a city on the brink of riots particularly after the violent killing of the prominent local politician and slumlord Munna Sonkar aka Kala Bachcha Seen as both a bulwark for Hindus against Muslims and a saviour of several of his Muslim tenants he was a study in contradiction and his murder was seen as the last straw by both communities *Murder in the Bylanes* is a gripping account of how a demoralised and broken police force reduced to being a bystander in pockets where criminals controlled localities was asked to maintain order It is also a reminder of how communal disharmony can tear apart our social fabric

Hate Spin Cherian George, 2016-09-23 How right wing political entrepreneurs around the world use religious offense both given and taken to mobilize supporters and marginalize opponents In the United States elements of the religious right fuel fears of an existential Islamic threat spreading anti Muslim rhetoric into mainstream politics In Indonesia Muslim absolutists urge suppression of churches and minority sects fostering a climate of rising intolerance In India Narendra Modi's radical supporters instigate communal riots and academic censorship in pursuit of their Hindu nationalist vision Outbreaks of religious intolerance are usually assumed to be visceral and spontaneous But in *Hate Spin* Cherian George shows that they often involve sophisticated campaigns manufactured by political opportunists to mobilize supporters and marginalize

opponents Right wing networks orchestrate the giving of offense and the taking of offense as instruments of identity politics exploiting democratic space to promote agendas that undermine democratic values George calls this strategy hate spin a double sided technique that combines hate speech incitement through vilification with manufactured offense taking the performing of righteous indignation It is deployed in societies as diverse as Buddhist Myanmar and Orthodox Christian Russia George looks at the world s three largest democracies where intolerant groups within India s Hindu right America s Christian right and Indonesia s Muslim right are all accomplished users of hate spin He also shows how the Internet and Google have opened up new opportunities for cross border hate spin George argues that governments must protect vulnerable communities by prohibiting calls to action that lead directly to discrimination and violence But laws that try to protect believers feelings against all provocative expression invariably backfire They arm hate spin agents offense taking campaigns with legal ammunition Anti discrimination laws and a commitment to religious equality will protect communities more meaningfully than misguided attempts to insulate them from insult

Western Muslims and Conflicts Abroad Juris Pupcenoks, 2015-12-07 This book explains why reactive conflict spillovers political violence in response to conflicts abroad occur in some migrant background communities in the West Based on survey data statistical datasets more than sixty interviews with Muslim community leaders and activists ethnographic research in London and Detroit and open source data this book develops a theoretical explanation for how both differences in government policies and features of migrant background communities interact to influence the nature of foreign policy focused activism in migrant communities Utilizing rigorous mixed methods case study analysis the author comparatively analyses the reactions of the Pakistani community in London and the Arab Muslim community in Detroit to the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq during the decade following 9 11 Both communities are politically mobilized and active However while London has experienced reactive conflict spillover Detroit has remained largely peaceful The key findings show that with regards to activism in response to foreign policy events Western Muslim communities primarily politically mobilize on the basis of their ethnic divisions Nevertheless one notable exception is the Arab Israeli conflict which is viewed through the Islamic lenses and the common Islamic identity is important in driving mobilization domestically in response to Islamophobia and counterterrorism policies and practices perceived to be discriminatory Certain organizational arrangements involving minority community leaders law enforcement and government officials help to effectively contain excitable youth who may otherwise engage in deviant behavior Overall the following factors contribute to the creation of an environment where reactive conflict spillover is more likely to occur policies allowing immigration of violent radicals poor economic integration without extensive civil society inter group ties the presence of radical groups and connections with radical networks abroad

Index to Book Reviews in Religion ,1999 Through Times of Trouble Anna Matveeva, 2017-12-20 This book tells the story of insurgency in Ukraine s Donbas region from the perspective of the rebels who sought and continue to seek either independence from Ukraine or unification with Russia As

such it provides a unique insight into their thinking and motivations which need to be understood if the conflict is to be resolved Those making and remaking the conflict are placed in the centre of the story which uses the words of the combatants themselves It shows how volunteer fighters driven by a wide and diffuse set of motivations emerged from Ukraine Russia and different parts of the world stood at the rebellion's heart The book focuses on the participants own voices and personalities drawing extensively on first hand research and interviews Rather than rendering Ukraine a chess piece on the geopolitical board the rebellion shows that ordinary people rather than elites can act as a decisive force Donbas says something about why large numbers of people make the decision to take part in a collective violent action when material rewards are low or non-existent and mortal risks high It stands as an important text on the study of modern insurgencies revealing how violent conflicts happen via issues of politicized identity and involvement of non-state actors This book places this conflict into the context of other conflicts worldwide and demonstrates how ideas and narratives are constructed to provide meaning to a struggle The insurgency has produced a conflict sub-culture rich with symbolism narrative and communications made possible by the digital age and a social media savvy population These beliefs and ideas have had the power to pull people from different parts of the world This book follows the stages of assembling different conflict ingredients together and the rebellion's zigzagging fortunes after it became apparent that Moscow was not going to repeat the Crimea scenario in Donbas It analyses the logic of armed struggle and the tactics deployed by warring parties It also sheds light on the developments in Moscow discusses the phenomenon of the Russian Spring movement and concludes with the prospects for a peaceful solution

Dynamics of Caste and Law Dag-Erik Berg, 2020-02-27 *Dynamics of Caste and Law* breaks new ground in understanding how caste and law relate in India's democratic order Caste has become a visible phenomenon often associated with discrimination inequality and politics in India and globally India's constitutional democracy has had a remarkable goal of creating equality in a context of caste Despite constitutional promises with equal opportunities for the lower castes and outlawing of untouchability at the time of independence recurring atrocities and inadequate implementation of law have called for rethinking and legal change This book sheds new light on why caste oppression persists by using new theoretical perspectives as well as Bhimrao Ambedkar's concepts of the caste system Focusing on struggles among India's Dalits the castes formerly known as untouchables the book draws on a rich material and explains among other things mechanisms of oppression and how powerful actors may gain influence in institutions of law and state

Joldon Kutmanaliev, 2023-05-08 With increasing urban population density conflicts in cities erupt more frequently and violently Cities have become hotspots for armed combat highlighting the urgency of understanding the impact of local communities and urban factors on the development of violent conflict Joldon Kutmanaliev presents a novel approach to analyzing communal violence and armed conflicts in urban zones Drawing from fieldwork in cities of southern Kyrgyzstan he explains local level variations in violence across neighbourhoods during the most intense and violent episode of urban communal violence in Central Asia the clashes between Kyrgyz and Uzbeks in June 2010 Kutmanaliev explains why armed violence affects some urban neighbourhoods but not others why local communities react differently to the same existential threat how they deal with a deteriorating security environment and interethnic fears and how different types of urban planning and urban landscapes influence the spread of violence Importantly the book identifies

key factors that help local communities and their leaders to negotiate non aggression pacts and control local constituencies and therefore successfully prevent violence Intercommunal Warfare and Ethnic Peacemaking explains communal war and ethnic peacemaking on the level of neighbourhood communities a perspective that is largely absent in previous studies

Another India Pratinav Anil,2023-06-15 Another India tells the story of the world s biggest religious minority Weaving together vivid biographical portraits of a wide range of Indian Muslims elite and subaltern secular and clerical activist and apolitical it brings the experience of the country s Muslims under a single focus and by throwing light on the Indian Muslim condition during the first thirty years of independence reflects on the true character of democratic India What we have here is a rather different picture from received accounts of the world s largest democracy Challenging traditional histories of Nehru s India Pratinav Anil shows that minority rights were neglected right from independence Despite its best intentions the Congress regime that ruled for three decades was often illiberal intolerant and undemocratic Muslims had to contend with discrimination disadvantage deindustrialization dispossession and disenfranchisement as well as an unresponsive leadership Anil demonstrates how the Muslim elite encouraged depoliticization taking up seemingly noble but largely inconsequential causes with little bearing on the lives of ordinary members of the community There was no room for mass protests or collective solidarity in this version of Muslim politics Another India explores this elite betrayal whose consequences are still felt by India s 200 million Muslims today
