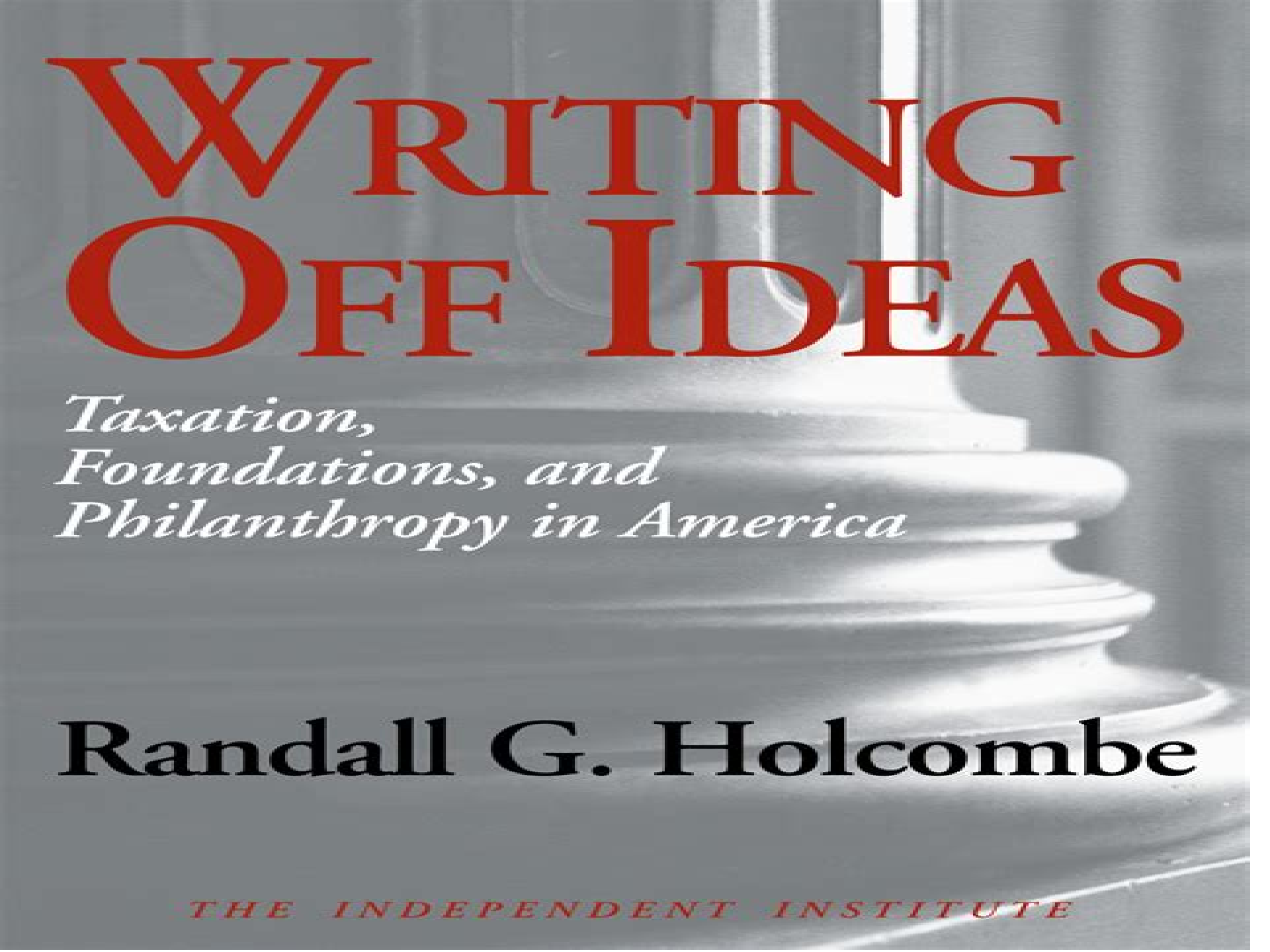

Liberty in Peril Randall G. Holcombe, 2019-09-01 When the United States was born in the revolutionary acts of 1776 Americans viewed the role of government as the protector of their individual rights Thus the fundamental principle underlying the new American government was liberty Over time the ideology of political democracy the idea that the role of government is to carry out the will of the people as revealed through majority rule has displaced the ethics of liberty This displacement has eroded individual rights systematically and that history is examined in *Liberty in Peril* by Randall Holcombe in language accessible to anyone The Founders intended to design a government that would preclude tyranny and protect those individual rights and the Bill of Rights was a clear statement of those rights They well understood that the most serious threat to human rights and liberty is government So the Constitution clearly outlined a limited scope for government and set forth a form of governance that would preserve individual rights The federal government s activities during two world wars and the Great Depression greatly increased government s involvement in people s lives By the time of Lyndon Johnson s Great Society the depletion of rights and the growth of the activities of political democracy was complete By the end of the 20th Century the fundamental principle underlying the U S government was now political power and not liberty Public policy was oriented toward fulfilling the majority rule with the subsequent increase in government power and scope Holcombe argues that economic and political systems are not separate entities but are intimately intertwined The result is a set of tensions between democracy liberty a market economy and the institutions of a free society All those interested in the evolution of American government including historians political scientists economists and legal experts will find this book compelling and informative

Drug War Crimes Jeffrey A. Miron, 2004-03-01 A balanced and sophisticated analysis of the true costs benefits and consequences of enforcing drug prohibition The War on Drugs claims thousands of lives every year in the United States Each year the U S government spends over 30 billion on the drug war and arrests 1.5 million American citizens on drug related charges There are now nearly half a million Americans imprisoned for drug offenses The official claim is that drug prohibition deters drug use reduces crime and improves public

health But is this claim valid In Drug War Crimes Jeffrey Miron offers a balanced and sophisticated analysis of the true costs benefits and consequences of drug prohibition The evidence yields a disturbing finding the more resources given to the Drug War the greater the homicide rate Miron then examines various alternatives to drug prohibition and identifies the most effective solution

Financing Failure Vern McKinley,2012-01-10 During the recent financial crisis no issue has aroused more passion than financial institution bailouts The standard rationale for the bailouts has been one of necessity and fear federal regulatory agencies must have more authority in order to respond to the crisis or else the public will face terrible consequences But does this rationale hold up to close inspection In Financing Failure Vern McKinley approaches the topic by examining the policy decisions behind the bailouts and by showing their connection to previous government interventions He brings under scrutiny the policy decisions made by the Treasury Department the Federal Reserve and the FDIC during the crisis of the 2000s and links them to policies that go back as far as the 1930s This history of bailouts reveals that the genesis of financial crisis is government policy be it the mismanagement of monetary policy during the 1930s or the political push to expand homeownership that helped cause the 2000s crisis The nation s federal financial regulators and the politicians claim to have saved the American economy In truth they have done everything within their power to expand their own influence often far out of view from the public and media Instead of openly explaining their actions the bailout agencies have attempted to prevent the public from reviewing their decision making often at tremendous cost to taxpayers McKinley s painstakingly researched and clear headed analysis of bailouts and government intervention shows that the American public has accepted too many official pronouncements at face value and that reining in the federal regulators is a necessary step toward truly promoting the safety and soundness of the financial system

Holcombe, 2017-07-05 Housing policy not only affects all Americans quality of life but has a direct impact on their financial well being About 70 percent of American households own their own homes and for most their homes represent the majority of their net worth Renters are affected by housing policy Even the small minority of Americans who are homeless are affected by housing policies specifically targeted to low income individuals The government's increasing involvement in housing markets fed by popular demand that government do something to address real problems of mortgage defaults and loans provides good reason to take a new look at the public sector in housing markets Crises in prime mortgage lending may lower the cost of housing but the poor and homeless cannot benefit because of increases in unemployment Even the private market is heavily regulated Government policies dictate whether people can build new housing on their land what type of housing they can build the terms allowed in rental contracts and much more This volume considers the effects of government housing policies and what can be done to make them work better It shows that many problems are the result of government rules and regulations Even in a time of foreclosures the market can still do a crucial job of allocating resources just as it does in other markets Consequently the appropriate policy response may well be to significantly reduce not increase government presence in housing markets Housing America is a courageous and comprehensive effort to examine housing policies in the United States and to show how such policies affect the housing market

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
