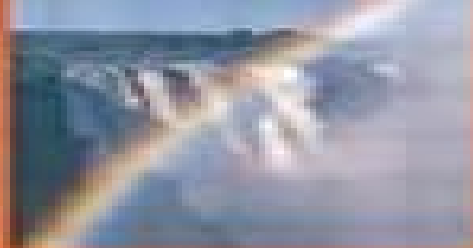

adapt and redefine their roles to the changing environment and technology. As a result of this change, different approaches in management operation and marketing strategies in the travel industry have emerged.
