rhizome the author takes a de territorialized approach to revolutionary filmmaking embracing the diversity and fluidity of revolutionary works in the Arab World As well as outlining the documentary film histories of the main film producing nations of the region Syria Lebanon Palestine Egypt Tunisia Algeria and Morocco the book analyzes the formal and esthetic features of individual works in relation to specific socio political historical developments Topics addressed include de colonization the wars of liberation the Tricontinental movement the Palestinian question the Rif Uprising the Leaden and Black Years civil war in Lebanon the recent Arab revolutions state authoritarianism and totalitarianism gender collectivism and political subjectivity Ultimately the book contributes to a general theory of revolutionary documentary film forms by studying the works of consecutive periods from different ideological contexts The book is much needed reading for students and academics interested in film and media studies and the history culture and politics of the Middle East and North Africa MENA region

African Film Josef Gugler, 2003 In *African Film Re imagining a Continent* Josef Gugler provides an introduction to African cinema through an analysis of 15 films made by African filmmakers These directors set out to re image Africa their films offer Western viewers the opportunity to re imagine the continent and its people As a point of comparison two additional films on Africa one from Hollywood the other from apartheid South Africa serve to highlight African directors altogether different perspectives Gugler s interpretation considers the financial and technical difficulties of African film production the intended audiences in Africa and the West the constraints on distribution and the critical reception of the films

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
