An Investigation in the Teaching of Vocal Health, Recovery and Rehabilitation in Vocal Pedagogy Courses at Selected Public Institutions Dionne Bateman DeLoach, 2000 Abstract This study examined post graduate vocal pedagogy courses and their contents at NASM accredited private liberal arts institutions located in Kentucky Tennessee Mississippi Louisiana Arkansas and Alabama The study focused on degree programs which included vocal pedagogy courses the content of post graduate vocal pedagogy courses and whether there is a unit on vocal health and recovery Eight vocal pedagogy instructors completed a questionnaire and seven participated in an interview It was found that vocal pedagogy was included in the Bachelor of Music and the Bachelor of Arts degree In the Masters program the Master of Music and the Master of Music Education included vocal pedagogy courses The Doctor of Arts and the Doctor of Musical Arts curricula also included vocal pedagogy courses Ten concepts anatomy physiology of the voice articulation breathing registration phonation posture resonance vocal health and hygiene were included in post graduate courses by all but one respondent Vocal health was discussed in the class by over half of the participants Topics included drugs and the voice misuse and abuse and diet None of the participants included recovery rehabilitation
