Whitman wrote for and about the common people and wanted his work to somehow bring about a political renewal that would truly represent the grand Idea of democracy. In this book Whitman overturns centuries of Western political and social thought. Whitman's democratic vision was something so unprecedented in so many ways that his reception at first could be characterized as utter incomprehension. It is believed that only a couple hundred people at most read the original 1855 edition of *Leaves of Grass* and many of these readers did not know what to make of the book.
