the batteries wherever their special skills were needed on the battlefield with no regiment to call a permanent home The 80th AAA battalion was a hybrid unit While its members were considered Coast Artillery the branch responsible for defending ground formations from air attack during WWII they fought alongside parachute and glider infantry most often providing direct fire anti armor support with 57mm 6 pounder cannons While field artillery both parachute and glider established their gunlines some distance behind infantry units to provide indirect fire support the men of the 80th fought face to face with the enemy alongside their infantry brothers US Army Paratrooper in the Pacific Theater 1943-45 Gordon L. Rottman, 2012-11-20 The two major Army units that operated in the Pacific the 11th Airborne Division and the 503rd Parachute Regimental Combat Team PRCT launched small scale operations on extremely difficult if not outright dangerous terrain while also conducting amphibious assaults fighting on jungled hills swamps and mud The two units were very different with the 503rd PRCT being reserved for special purpose missions and the 11th Airborne Division occupying a more traditional role This title will deal with the background to these two units and their training before detailing the specific equipment used in the theatre and finally and most importantly the combat experience at a personal level of the US Army Paratrooper in the Pacific **Blocking Kampfgruppe Peiper** Frank van Lunteren, 2015-09-19 The account of these elite paratroopers encounter with the Germans is a story of raw courage in the face of seemingly impossible odds a great read World War II In December 1944 an enormous German army group crashed through the thin American line in the Ardennes forest Caught by surprise the Allies were initially only able to throw two divisions of paratroopers to buttress the collapse the 82nd Airborne which was rushed to the area of St Vith and the 101st which was trucked to Bastogne After their successful campaign in Holland Col Reuben Tucker s elite 504th Parachute Infantry Regiment was resting and refitting in France when news came of the German breakthrough Most dangerous to the Allies was the German spearhead of the 1st SS Panzer Division led by Jochen Peiper which aimed to sever the Allied front The 504th was committed to block the SS advance and within forty eight hours of their arrival Col Tucker s paratroopers were attacking the SS Panzergrenadiers of Peiper s battlegroup eventually forcing them to withdraw More ferocious fighting ensued as follow up German units forced a US retreat from St Vith In adverse weather conditions against the German 9th SS Panzer and 3rd Fallschirmj ger Divisions the 504th lived up to its regimental motto Strike and Hold Although some rifle companies were whittled down to less than fifty paratroopers the Americans doggedly fought on until victory was achieved This work provides a fascinating up close view of the 504th PIR during the Battle of the Bulge as well as its gallant sacrifice Using never before published diaries letters battle reports and interviews with over a hundred veterans a comprehensive account is painted of a triumphant US regiment in one of the fiercest fought campaigns in the history of the US Army *Fighting Elites* John C.
