The Waterman's Song David S. Cecelski, 2012-01-01 The first major study of slavery in the maritime South The Waterman s Song chronicles the world of slave and free black fishermen pilots rivermen sailors ferrymen and other laborers who from the colonial era through Reconstruction plied the vast inland waters of North Carolina from the Outer Banks to the upper reaches of tidewater rivers Demonstrating the vitality and significance of this local African American maritime culture David Cecelski also reveals its connections to the Afro Caribbean the relatively egalitarian work culture of seafaring men who visited nearby ports and the revolutionary political tides that coursed throughout the black Atlantic Black maritime laborers played an essential role in local abolitionist activity slave insurrections and other antislavery activism They also boatlifted thousands of slaves to freedom during the Civil War But most important Cecelski says they carried an insurgent democratic vision born in the maritime districts of the slave South into the political maelstrom of the Civil War and Reconstruction

A History of North Carolina in the Proprietary Era, 1629-1729 Lindley S. Butler, 2022-03-10 In this book Lindley S Butler traverses oft noted but little understood events in the political and social establishment of the Carolina colony In the wake of the English Civil Wars in the mid seventeenth century King Charles II granted charters to eight Lords Proprietors to establish civil structures levy duties and taxes and develop a vast tract of land along the southeastern Atlantic coast Butler argues that unlike the New England theocracies and Chesapeake plantocracy the isolated colonial settlements of the Albemarle the cradle of today s North Carolina saw their power originate neither in the authority of the church nor in wealth extracted through slave labor but rather in institutions that emphasized political legal and religious freedom for white male landholders Despite this distinct pattern of economic legal and religious development however the colony could not avoid conflict among the diverse assemblage of Indigenous European and African people living there all of whom contributed to the future of the state and nation that took shape in subsequent years Butler provides the first comprehensive history of the proprietary era in North Carolina since the nineteenth century offering a substantial and accessible reappraisal of this key historical period

The Land Was Ours Andrew W. Kahrl, 2016-06-27 The coasts of today s American South feature luxury condominiums resorts and gated communities yet just a century ago a surprising amount of beachfront property in the Chesapeake along the Carolina shores and around the Gulf of Mexico was owned and populated by African Americans Blending social and environmental history Andrew W Kahrl tells the story of African American owned beaches in the twentieth century By reconstructing African American life along the coast Kahrl demonstrates just how important these properties were for African American communities and leisure as well as for economic empowerment especially during the era of the Jim Crow South However in the wake of the civil rights movement and amid the growing prosperity of the Sunbelt many African Americans fell victim to effective campaigns to dispossess black landowners of their properties and beaches Kahrl makes a

Diouf,2014-01-17 The forgotten stories of America maroons wilderness settlers evading discovery after escaping slavery Over more than two centuries men women and children escaped from slavery to make the Southern wilderness their home They hid in the mountains of Virginia and the low swamps of South Carolina they stayed in the neighborhood or paddled their way to secluded places they buried themselves underground or built comfortable settlements Known as maroons they lived on their own or set up communities in swamps or other areas where they were not likely to be discovered Although well known feared celebrated or demonized at the time the maroons whose stories are the subject of this book have been forgotten overlooked by academic research that has focused on the Caribbean and Latin America Who the American maroons were what led them to choose this way of life over alternatives what forms of marronage they created what their individual and collective lives were like how they organized themselves to survive and how their particular story fits into the larger narrative of slave resistance are questions that this book seeks to answer To survive the American maroons reinvented themselves defied slave society enforced their own definition of freedom and dared create their own alternative to what the country had delineated as being black men and women s proper place Audacious self confident autonomous sometimes self sufficient always self governing their very existence was a repudiation of the basic

reveal a colony enmeshed in covert commerce Forsaken by the Spanish fleet system Venezuelan colonists struggled to obtain European foods and goods They found a solution in exchanging cacao a coveted luxury for the necessities of life provided by contrabandists from the Dutch English and French Caribbean Jesse Cromwell paints a vivid picture of the lives of littoral peoples who normalized their subversions of imperial law Yet laws and borders began to matter when the Spanish state cracked down on illicit commerce in the 1720s as part of early Bourbon reforms Now successful merchants could become convict laborers just as easily as enslaved Africans could become free traders along the unruly coastlines of the Spanish Main Smuggling became more than an economic transaction or imperial worry persistent local need elevated the practice to a communal ethos and Venezuelans defended their commercial autonomy through passive measures and even violent political protests Negotiations between the Spanish state and its subjects over smuggling formed a key part of empire making and maintenance in the eighteenth century

The Fight for the Old North State Hampton Newsome,2020-08-04 On a cold day in early January 1864 Robert E Lee wrote to Confederate president Jefferson Davis The time is at hand when if an attempt can be made to capture the enemy s forces at New Berne it should be done Over the next few months Lee s dispatch would precipitate a momentous series of events as the Confederates threatened by a supply crisis and an emerging peace movement sought to seize Federal bases in eastern North Carolina This book tells the story of these operations the late war Confederate resurgence in the Old North State Using rail lines to rapidly consolidate their forces the Confederates would attack the main Federal position at New Bern in February raid the northeastern counties in March hit the Union garrisons at Plymouth and Washington in late April and conclude with another attempt at New Bern in early May The expeditions would involve joint service operations as the Confederates looked to support their attacks with powerful homegrown ironclad gunboats These offensives in early 1864 would witness the failures and successes of southern commanders including George Pickett James Cooke and a young aggressive North Carolinian named Robert Hoke Likewise they would challenge the leadership of Union army and naval officers such as Benjamin Butler John Peck and Charles Flusser Newsome does not neglect the broader context revealing how these military events related to a contested gubernatorial election the social transformations in the state brought on by the war the execution of Union prisoners at Kinston and the activities of North Carolina Unionists Lee s January proposal triggered one of the last successful Confederate offensives The Fight for the Old North State captures the full scope as well as the dramatic details of this struggle for North Carolina

Race and Education in New Orleans Walter Stern, 2018-05-04 Surveying the two centuries that preceded Jim Crow s demise *Race and Education in New Orleans* traces the course of the city s education system from the colonial period to the start of school desegregation in 1960 This timely historical analysis reveals that public schools in New Orleans both suffered from and maintained the racial stratification that characterized urban areas for much of the twentieth century Walter C Stern begins his account with the mid eighteenth century kidnapping and enslavement of Marie Justine Sirnir who eventually secured her freedom and played a major role in the development of free black education in the Crescent City As Sirnir s story and legacy illustrate schools such as the one she envisioned were central to the black antebellum understanding of race citizenship and urban development Black communities fought tirelessly to gain better access to education which gave rise to new strategies by white civilians and officials who worked to maintain and strengthen the racial status quo even as they conceded to demands from the black community for expanded educational opportunities The friction between black and white New Orleanians continued throughout the nineteenth century and well into the twentieth when conflicts over land and resources sharply intensified Stern argues that the post Reconstruction reorganization of the city into distinct black and white enclaves marked a new phase in the evolution of racial disparity segregated schools gave rise to segregated communities which in turn created structural inequality in housing that impeded desegregation s capacity to promote racial justice By taking a long view of the interplay between education race and urban change Stern underscores the fluidity of race as a social construct and the extent to which the Jim Crow system evolved through a dynamic though often improvisational process A vital and accessible history *Race and Education in New Orleans* provides a comprehensive look at the ways the New Orleans school system shaped the city s racial and urban landscapes

Rebellious Passage Jeffrey R.

Kerr-Ritchie,2019-02-07 In late October 1841 the Creole left Richmond with 137 slaves bound for New Orleans It arrived five weeks later minus the Captain one passenger and most of the captives Nineteen rebels had seized the US slave ship en route and steered it to the British Bahamas where the slaves gained their liberty Drawing upon a sweeping array of previously unexamined state federal and British colonial sources *Rebellious Passage* examines the neglected maritime dimensions of the extensive US slave trade and slave revolt The focus on south to south self emancipators at sea differs from the familiar narrative of south to north fugitive slaves over land Moreover a broader hemispheric framework of clashing slavery and antislavery empires replaces an emphasis on US antebellum sectional rivalry Written with verve and commitment *Rebellious Passage* chronicles the first comprehensive history of the ship revolt its consequences and its relevance to global modern slavery

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
