Building the Skyline Jason M. Barr, 2016-05-12 The Manhattan skyline is one of the great wonders of the modern world But how and why did it form Much has been written about the city s architecture and its general history but little work has explored the economic forces that created the skyline In Building the Skyline Jason Barr chronicles the economic history of the Manhattan skyline In the process he debunks some widely held misconceptions about the city s history Starting with Manhattan s natural and geological history Barr moves on to how these formations influenced early land use and the development of neighborhoods including the dense tenement neighborhoods of Five Points and the Lower East Side and how these early decisions eventually impacted the location of skyscrapers built during the Skyscraper Revolution at the end of the 19th century Barr then explores the economic history of skyscrapers and the skyline investigating the reasons for their heights frequencies locations and shapes He discusses why skyscrapers emerged downtown and why they appeared three miles to the north in midtown but not in between the two areas Contrary to popular belief this was not due to the depths of Manhattan s bedrock nor the presence of Grand Central Station Rather midtown s emergence was a response to the economic and demographic forces that were taking place north of 14th Street after the Civil War Building the Skyline also presents the first rigorous investigation of the causes of the building boom during the Roaring Twenties Contrary to conventional wisdom the boom was largely a rational response to the economic growth of the nation and city The last chapter investigates the value of Manhattan Island and the relationship between skyscrapers and land prices Finally an Epilogue offers policy recommendations for a resilient and robust future skyline

Hard Bargains Mona Lynch,2016-11-01 The convergence of tough on crime politics stiffer sentencing laws and jurisdictional expansion in the 1970s and 1980s increased the powers of federal prosecutors in unprecedented ways In Hard Bargains social psychologist Mona Lynch investigates the increased power of these prosecutors in our age of mass incarceration Lynch documents how prosecutors use punitive federal drug laws to coerce guilty pleas and obtain long prison sentences for defendants particularly those who are African American and exposes deep injustices in the federal courts As a result of the War on Drugs the number of drug cases prosecuted each year in federal courts has increased fivefold since 1980 Lynch goes behind the scenes in three federal court districts and finds that federal prosecutors have considerable discretion in adjudicating these cases Federal drug laws are wielded differently in each district but with such force to overwhelm defendants ability to assert their rights For drug defendants with prior convictions the stakes are even higher since prosecutors can file charges that incur lengthy prison sentences including life in prison without parole Through extensive field research Lynch finds that prosecutors frequently use the threat of extremely severe sentences to compel defendants to plead guilty rather than go to trial and risk much harsher punishment Lynch also shows that the highly discretionary ways in which federal prosecutors work with law enforcement have led to significant racial disparities in federal courts For instance most federal charges for crack cocaine offenses are brought against African Americans even though whites are more likely to use crack In addition Latinos are increasingly entering the federal system as a result of aggressive immigration crackdowns that also target illicit drugs Hard Bargains provides an incisive and revealing look at how legal reforms over the last five decades have shifted excessive authority to federal prosecutors resulting in the erosion of defendants rights and extreme sentences for those convicted Lynch proposes a broad overhaul of the federal criminal justice system to restore the balance of power and retreat from the punitive indulgences of the War on Drugs      *Pathways to Urban Sustainability* National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine,Policy and Global Affairs,Science and Technology for Sustainability Program,Committee on Pathways to Urban Sustainability: Challenges and Opportunities,2016-11-11 Cities have experienced an unprecedented rate of growth in the last decade More than half the world s population lives in urban areas with the U S percentage at 80 percent Cities have captured more than 80 percent of the globe s economic activity and offered social mobility and economic prosperity to millions by clustering creative innovative and educated individuals and organizations Clustering populations however can compound both positive and negative conditions with many modern urban areas experiencing growing inequality debility and environmental degradation The spread and continued growth of urban areas presents a number of concerns for a sustainable future particularly if cities cannot adequately address the rise of poverty hunger resource consumption and biodiversity loss in their borders Intended as a comparative illustration of the types of
