1. Choose strong words that create effective sentences and coherent paragraphs.

3 Complete

Revise the Message

1. Evaluate content and review readability.
2. Edit and rewrite for conciseness and clarity.

Produce the Message

1. Use effective design elements for a clean and professional layout.

Proofread the Message

1. Review for errors in layout; spelling and mechanics.

Distribute the Message
