Since the beginning of time or at least the era of Archimedes smooth manifolds curves surfaces mechanical configurations the universe have been a central focus in mathematics. They have always been at the core of interest in topology After the seminal work of Milnor Smale and many others in the last half of this century the topological aspects of smooth manifolds as distinct from the differential geometric aspects became a subject in its own right
