Bredon, 2013-03-09 The golden age of mathematics that was not the age of Euclid it is ours C J KEYSER This time of writing is the hundredth anniversary of the publication 1892 of Poincare's first note on topology which arguably marks the beginning of the subject of algebraic or combinatorial topology There was earlier scattered work by Euler Listing who coined the word topology Mobius and his band Riemann Klein and Betti Indeed even as early as 1679 Leibniz indicated the desirability of creating a geometry of the topological type The establishment of topology or analysis situs as it was often called at the time as a coherent theory however belongs to Poincare Curiously the beginning of general topology also called point set topology dates fourteen years later when Frechet published the first abstract treatment of the subject in 1906 Since the beginning of time or at least the era of Archimedes smooth manifolds curves surfaces mechanical configurations the universe have been a central focus in mathematics They have always been at the core of interest in topology After the seminal work of Milnor Smale and many others in the last half of this century the topological aspects of smooth manifolds as distinct from the differential geometric aspects became a subject in its own right

The goal of this monograph is to develop Hopf theory in a new setting which features centrally a real hyperplane arrangement. The new theory is parallel to the classical theory of connected Hopf algebras and relates to it when specialized to the braid arrangement. Joyal's theory of combinatorial species, ideas from Tits' theory of buildings and Rota's work on incidence algebras inspire and find a common expression in this theory. The authors introduce notions of monoid comonoid, bimonoid and Lie monoid relative to a fixed hyperplane arrangement. They also construct universal bimonoids by using generalizations of the classical notions of shuffle and quasishuffle and establish the Borel-Hopf-Poincaré-Birkhoff-Witt and Cartier-Milnor-Moore theorems in this setting. This monograph opens a vast new area of research. It will be of interest to students and researchers working in the areas of hyperplane arrangements, semigroup theory, Hopf algebras, algebraic Lie theory, operads and category theory.

Algebraic Topology William Fulton, 1997-09-05. To the Teacher: This book is designed to introduce a student to some of the important ideas of algebraic topology by emphasizing the relations of these ideas with other areas of mathematics. Rather than choosing one point of view of modern topology—homotopy theory, simplicial complexes, singular theory, axiomatic homology, differential topology, etc—we concentrate our attention on concrete problems in low dimensions, introducing only as much algebraic machinery as necessary for the problems we meet. This makes it possible to see a wider variety of important features of the subject than is usual in a beginning text. The book is designed for students of mathematics or science who are not aiming to become practicing algebraic topologists; without, we hope, discouraging budding topologists. We also feel that this approach is in better harmony with the historical development of the subject. Our answers to this have guided the choice of material, which includes understanding the relation between homology and integration, first on plane domains, later on Riemann surfaces, and in higher dimensions; winding numbers and degrees of mappings; fixed point theorems; applications such as the Jordan curve theorem; invariance of domain; index of vector fields; and Euler characteristics; fundamental groups.
