The Cities of the Plain Robin Rönnlund, 2023-09-30 This book explores urbanism in Antiquity from an archaeological perspective focusing on the area of western Thessaly in central Greece Presenting all the available evidence for ancient urban sites in the region the study outlines and discusses the origins development and decline of urbanism in the area The archaeological evidence shows that urban sites in western Thessaly developed from the mid 4th century BCE with at least 25 identified contemporaneous cities spread over the area These cities appear to have been planned and organised from the

onset with regular street grids fortification systems and water supply works but were generally short lived typically existing for only five six generations Most of the sites were completely or nearly completely abandoned as settlements in the early 2nd century BCE often with evidence of violent destruction and only a handful survived as smaller regional centres under the Roman administration Restorations of the former urban sites and especially their fortifications occur towards the end of Antiquity especially the first half of the 6th century CE but re occupation appears again to have been short lived as only three cities survived into the Middle Ages From a regional perspective the study shows that the rise and fall of urbanism itself did not necessarily cause complete socio political disruption but rather reflect changes in regional and supra regional political organisation On a global scale the study exemplifies the political nature of the pre Industrial city its synthetic rather than organic role in agrarian societies and the cyclic nature of urbanity in history The book contains an extensive catalogue presenting each site with photographs topographical sketches and complete bibliography

Graziano Salvalai, Enrico Quagliarini, Juan Diego Blanco Cadena, Gabriele Bernardini, 2024-02-16 The book provides an overview of the Slow Onset Disasters SLOD in the urban built environment discussing potential strategies to assess and mitigate multiple climate change related risks Climate change evidence has been reported in the last decades suggesting that the anthropogenic activities are accelerating these changes towards a warmer and more polluted environment In this context SLODs have been linked to climate change related disasters and have been stated to have a higher impact risk within dense built environment BE Therefore the book presents a description of the most relevant SLODs their significance and confluence the way in which scientists and entities are monitoring their progression at different scales a structured risk assessment strategy and the deconstruction of the BE characteristics that make it more prone to SLODs risk In addition it highlights the necessity of adapting the traditional risk assessment methods to account for different vulnerability types including the morphology and materiality of the BE and the BE users characteristics In fact individual features influence users responses and tolerance to environmental stressors because of age health gender habits and behaviour thus impacting the users vulnerability Exposure can then amplify these issues since it defines the number of users that can be effectively affected by the SLOD Starting from this perspective the book first traces literature based correlations between individual features use behaviour and individual response to the SLOD altered open spaces Then a novel methodology to quantify the variations of users vulnerability and exposure is offered to support designers in quickly defining input scenarios for risk assessment and mitigation Lastly it demonstrates through a case study the SLOD risk assessment framework proposed and the evaluation of the efficacy of risk mitigation strategies

Chrysanthi Gallou, 2019-12-27 A Silent Place Death in Mycenaean Lakonia is the first book length systematic study of the Late Bronze Age LBA burial tradition in south eastern Peloponnese Greece and the first to comprehensively present and discuss all Mycenaean tombs and funerary contexts excavated and or simply reported in the region from the 19th century to present day The book will discuss and reconstruct the emergence and development of the Mycenaean mortuary tradition in Lakonia by examining the landscape of death the burial architecture the funerary and post funerary customs and rituals and offering patterns over a longue dur e The author proposes patterns of continuity from the Middle Bronze Age even the Early Bronze Age in terms of burial architecture to the LBA and equally important from the Late Bronze Age to the Early Iron Age and reconstructs diachronic processes of invention of tradition and identity in Mycenaean communities on the basis of tomb types and their material culture The text highlights the social political and economic history of Late Bronze Age Lakonia from the evolution of the Mycenaean civilisation and the establishment of palatial administration in the Spartan vale to the demise of Mycenaean culture and the turbulent post collapse centuries as reflected by the burial offerings The book also brings to publication the chamber tombs at Epidavros Limera that remained largely unpublished since their excavation in the 1930s and 1950s Epidavros Limera was one of the most important prehistoric coastal sites in prehistoric southern Greece early 3rd late 4th millennium BC and one of the main harbour towns of the Mycenaean administrative centres of central Lakonia It is one of very few Mycenaean sites that flourished uninterruptedly from the emergence of the Mycenaean civilisation until after the collapse of the palatial administration and into the transition to the Early Iron Age The present study of the funerary architecture and of the pottery from the tombs suggests that the site was responsible for the introduction of the chamber tomb type on the Greek mainland in the latest phase of the Middle Bronze Age definitely no later than the transitional Middle Bronze Age Late Bronze Age period and not in the early phase of the Late Bronze Age Late Helladic I as previously assumed
