Islamophobia and Radicalisation Tahir Abbas, 2019 Since the 1970s there have been three challenges to traditional homogeneous national identities across the Western world political and socioeconomic inequality neoliberal globalization and more diverse multicultural societies As in the US and elsewhere in Western Europe the decline of an old masculinized national identity has now begun to open a new dark era for Britain Ever since the war on terror was added to the mix others in Britain have been brutally demonized Muslims routinely presented as the source of society's ills are subjected to both symbolic and actual violence Deep seated and structurally racialized norms amplify the isolation and alienation impeding Muslim integration Both these left behind Muslims and white British groups who perceive themselves as the true nation are under pressure from ongoing geopolitical concerns in the Muslim world as well as widening divisions at home Tahir Abbas argues that in this context the symbiotic intersections between Islamophobia and radicalization intensify and expand His book is a warning of the world that results a rise in hate crime the institutionalization of Islamophobia and the normalization of war and conflict

The Making of Anti-Muslim Protest Joel Busher, 2015-10-23 Activism in any social movement group is as Deborah Gould observes a project of collective world making It is about changing the world out there by influencing policy and public opinion but is also about the way it transforms the lives of participants activists generate new identities cultures social ties rich and varied emotional experiences and interpretations of the world around them Movements are more likely to be able to attract and sustain support when as projects of collective world making they feel compelling to activists and would be activists In this book Busher explores what has made activism in the English Defence League EDL an anti Muslim protest movement that has staged demonstrations across the UK since 2009 so compelling to those who have chosen to march under its banner Based on sixteen months of overt observation with grassroots activists he explores how people became involved with the group how they forged and intensified belief in the EDL cause how they negotiated accusations that they were just another racist far right group and how grassroots EDL activism began to unravel during the course of 2011 but did not do so altogether Providing a fresh insight as to how contemporary anti minority protest movements work on the inside this book will be of interest to students scholars and activists working in the areas of British politics extremism social movements community relations and current affairs more generally

"The Sons of Pigs and Apes" Neil J. Kressel, 2012-08-01 From the 1950s through the 1990s antisemitism everywhere seemed to be on the wane But as Neil Kressel documents in this startling book the Muslim world has resurrected in recent decades almost every diatribe that more than two millennia of European hostility produced against the Jews and it has introduced many homegrown and novel modes of attack Though it is impossible to determine precisely how many of the world's 1.2 billion Muslims hold anti Jewish beliefs Kressel finds that much bigotry comes from the highest levels of religious and political leadership Compounding the problem as Kressel demonstrates many in the West refuse to recognize this issue The growing epidemic of hate has been largely ignored

misunderstood or downplayed Kressel reveals because of apathy ignorance confusion bigotry ideology purported pragmatism and misguided multiculturalism Those who value human rights ignore antisemitism at their own risk he cautions noting that no antisemitic regime or movement has ever been otherwise reasonable or progressive Kressel argues convincingly that Muslim antisemitism provides an acid test of the seriousness of Western liberalism If the West fails to stem this growing tide as now seems likely future affairs will not go well for the true proponents of democracy Kressel moves beyond sounding the alarm to explore the diverse religious political social and psychological forces that have created and nurtured the new hostility to Jews in the Muslim world he concludes with a bold and clear plan for what must be done to confront this hostility
