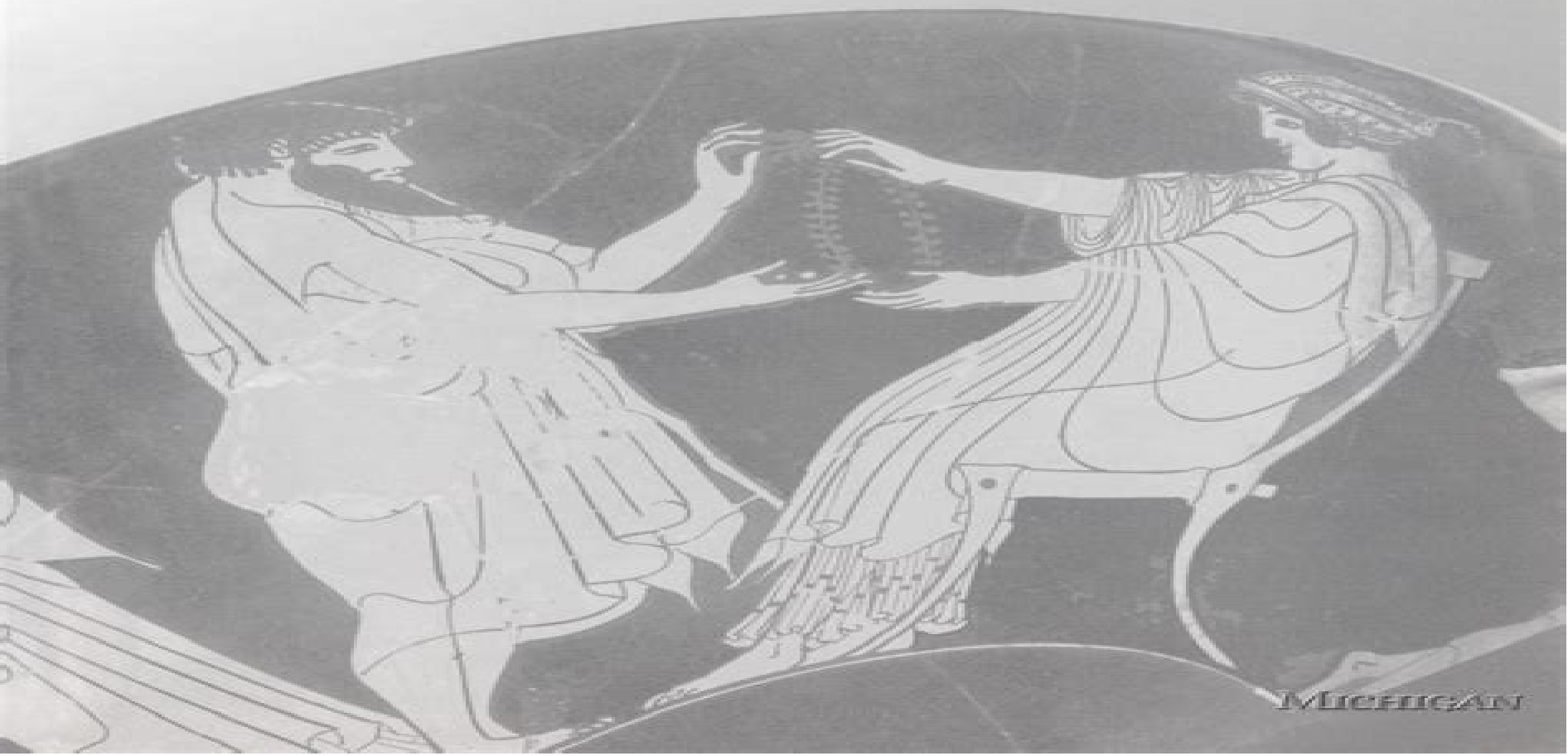

achieved when the benefits of participation for the member states exceed the costs of conferring national sovereignty on supranational federal authorities The book further argues that the Achaeans developed a system of sophisticated direct democratic procedures in decision making on federal matters as well as significant and highly sophisticated for the era economic institutions and federal practices in order to achieve bonds of trust and legitimacy regarding their innovative federal structure These practices included among others the creation of free market type economic institutions a monetary union federal budget provision of public goods and a common defense and security policy for all the Achaean city state members Lastly the book relates these findings to ideas on how the Achaean Federation would have dealt with a series of current global issues such as European Union integration and problems such as Euroscepticism Brexit and immigration
