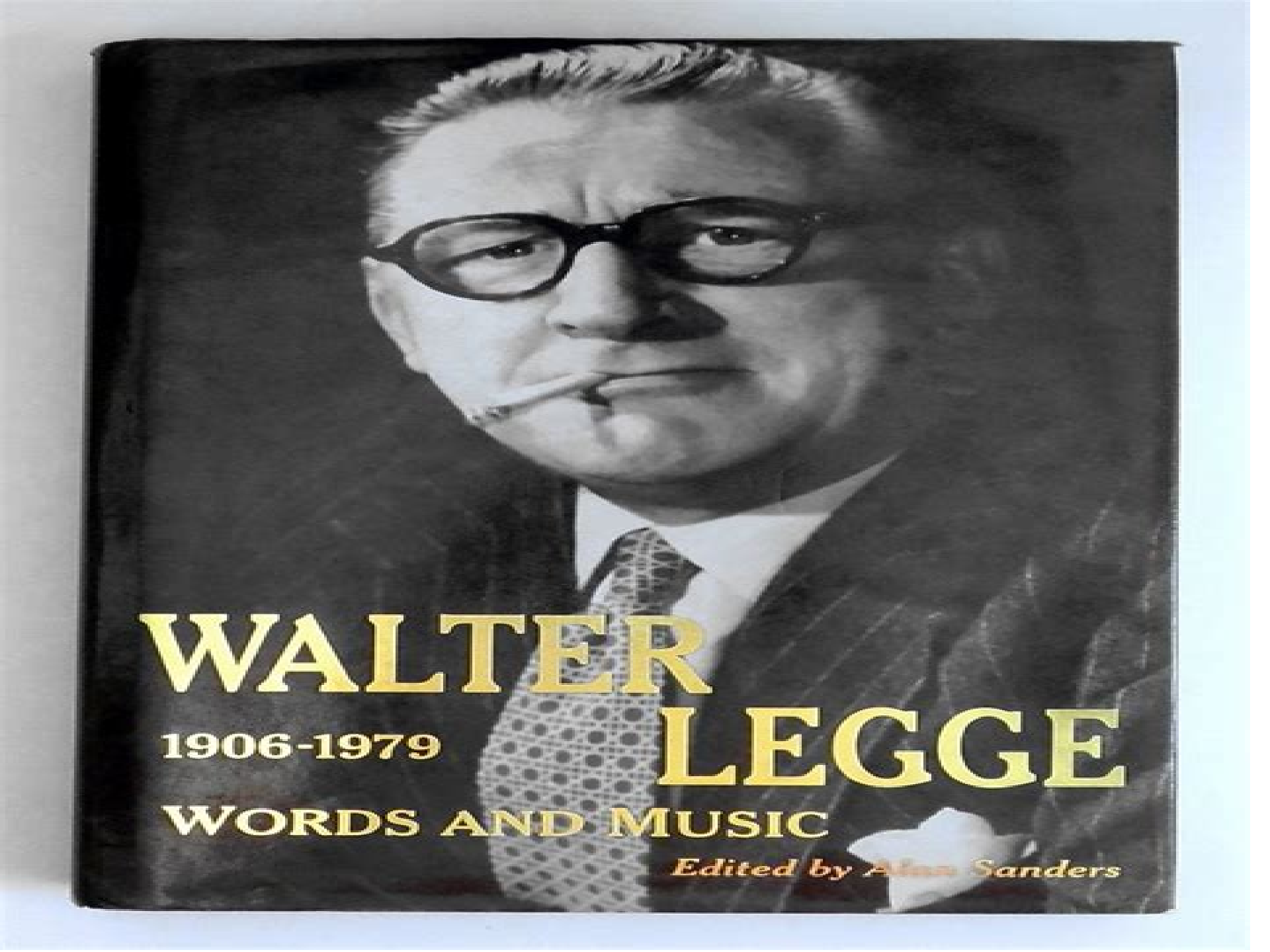

Toscanini in Britain Christopher Dymont,2012 This is the first book to describe Arturo Toscanini s activities the life he led his concerts and recording sessions during his visits to London and elsewhere in Britain in the years 1900 1952 During the 1930s Arturo Toscanini conducted many concerts broadcast by the BBC from London s Queen s Hall where he also made some unsurpassed recordings Drawing on newly researched material in British and American archives Christopher Dymont reveals how the most renowned and influential conductor of the twentieth century notoriously microphone shy though he was came to conduct so frequently in London a tale replete with unexpected twists turns and ingenious stratagems Toscanini s dominating influence on London critics and audiences in the period covered by the narrative extending through to his final appearances at the Royal Festival Hall in 1952 is copiously documented from contemporary sources Dymont also presents fresh evidence showing how the remarkable combination of passionate conviction and architectural mastery that characterised Toscanini s conducting was grounded not only in his obsessive study of the score but also in his awareness of performing traditions dating back to the mid nineteenth century This book will fascinate those with a particular interest in Toscanini s career and recorded legacy It is also essential reading for anyone with an interest in the history of conducting and recording in the first half of the twentieth century set against the vividly evoked backdrop of London s concert scene of the period This comprehensive study includes both an annotated table of all Toscanini s London concerts and his EMI discography CHRISTOPHER DYMENT has written extensively about historic conductors since the 1970s particularly Felix Weingartner and Arturo Toscanini His first book on Weingartner was published in 1976

Dennis Brain Stephen Gamble, William C. Lynch, 2011 The British horn player Dennis Brain 1921 1957 is commonly described by such statements as the greatest horn player of the 20th Century a genius and a legend He was both a prodigy and popularizer famously performing a concerto on a garden hose in perfect pitch On his usual concert instrument his tone was of unsurpassed beauty and clarity complemented by a flawless technique The recordings he made with Herbert von Karajan of Mozart's horn concerti are considered the definitive interpretations Brain enlisted in the English armed forces during World War II for seven years joining the National Symphony Orchestra in wartime in 1942 After the war he filled the principal horn positions in both the Philharmonia and Royal Philharmonic Orchestras He later formed his own wind quintet and began conducting Composers including Benjamin Britten and Paul Hindemith lined up to write music for him Even fifty years after his tragic death at the age of 36 in an auto accident in 1957 Peter Maxwell Davies was commissioned to write a piece in his honor Stephen Gamble and William Lynch have conducted numerous interviews with family friends and colleagues and uncovered information in the BBC archives and other lesser known sources about recordings that were previously unknown This volume describes Brain's life and analyzes in depth his musical career Its appendices of information on performances will appeal to music historians and its details on Brain's instruments and equipment will be useful to horn players

Indian Classical Music and the Gramophone, 1900-1930 Vikram Sampath, 2022-06-30 In 1902 The Gramophone Company in London sent out recording experts on expeditions across the world to record voices from different cultures and backgrounds All over India it was women who embraced the challenge of overcoming numerous social taboos and aesthetic handicaps that came along with this nascent technology Women who took the plunge and recorded largely belonged to the courtesan community called tawaifs and devadasis in North and South India respectively Recording brought with it great fame brand recognition freedom from exploitative patrons and monetary benefits to the women singers They were to become pioneers of the music industry in the Indian sub continent However despite the pioneering role played by these women their stories have largely been forgotten Contemporaneous with the courtesan women adapting to recording technology was the anti nautch campaign that sought to abolish these women from the performing space and brand them as common prostitutes A vigorous renaissance and arts revival movement followed leading to the creation of a new classical paradigm in both North Indian Hindustani and South Indian Carnatic classical music This resulted in the standardization universalization and institutionalization of Indian classical music This newly created classical

paradigm impacted future recordings of The Gramophone Company in terms of a shift in genres and styles Vikram Sampath sheds light on the role and impact of The Gramophone Company's early recording expeditions on Indian classical music by examining the phenomenon through a sociocultural historical and musical lens The book features the indefatigable stories of the women and their experiences in adapting to recording technology The artists from across India featured are Gauhar Jaan of Calcutta Janki Bai of Allahabad Zohra Bai of Agra Malka Jaan of Agra Salem Godavari Bangalore Nagarathnamma Coimbatore Thayi Dhanakoti of Kanchipuram Bai Sundarabai of Pune and Husna Jaan of Banaras

Hamilton Harty Jeremy Dibble, 2013 An in depth study of the life of Sir Hamilton Harty 1879-1941 pianist composer and conductor of the Hall Orchestra who arguably made Manchester the most important focus for music in Britain in his day Sir Hamilton Harty 1879-1941 is best known as the conductor of the Hall Orchestra who arguably made Manchester the most important focus for music in Britain in his day This book chronicles and analyses Harty's illustrious career from his establishment as London's premiere accompanist in 1901 to his years as a conductor between 1910 and 1933 first with the LSO and then with the Hall to his American tours of the 1930s Tragically Harty died from cancer in 1941 at the age of only 61 This book also looks at Harty's life as a composer of orchestral and chamber works and songs notably before the First World War Although Harty's music cleaved strongly to a late nineteenth century musical language he was profoundly influenced during his days in Ulster and Dublin by the Irish literary revival A great exponent of Mozart and especially Berlioz Harty was also a keen exponent of

British music and an active supporter of American composers such as Gershwin Harty's role in the exposition of standard and new repertoire and his relationship with contemporary composers and performers are also examined against the perspective of other important major British conductors such as Sir Thomas Beecham Malcolm Sargent and Sir Henry Wood. Additionally the book analyses the debates Harty provoked on the subjects of women orchestral players jazz modernism and the music of Berlioz.
