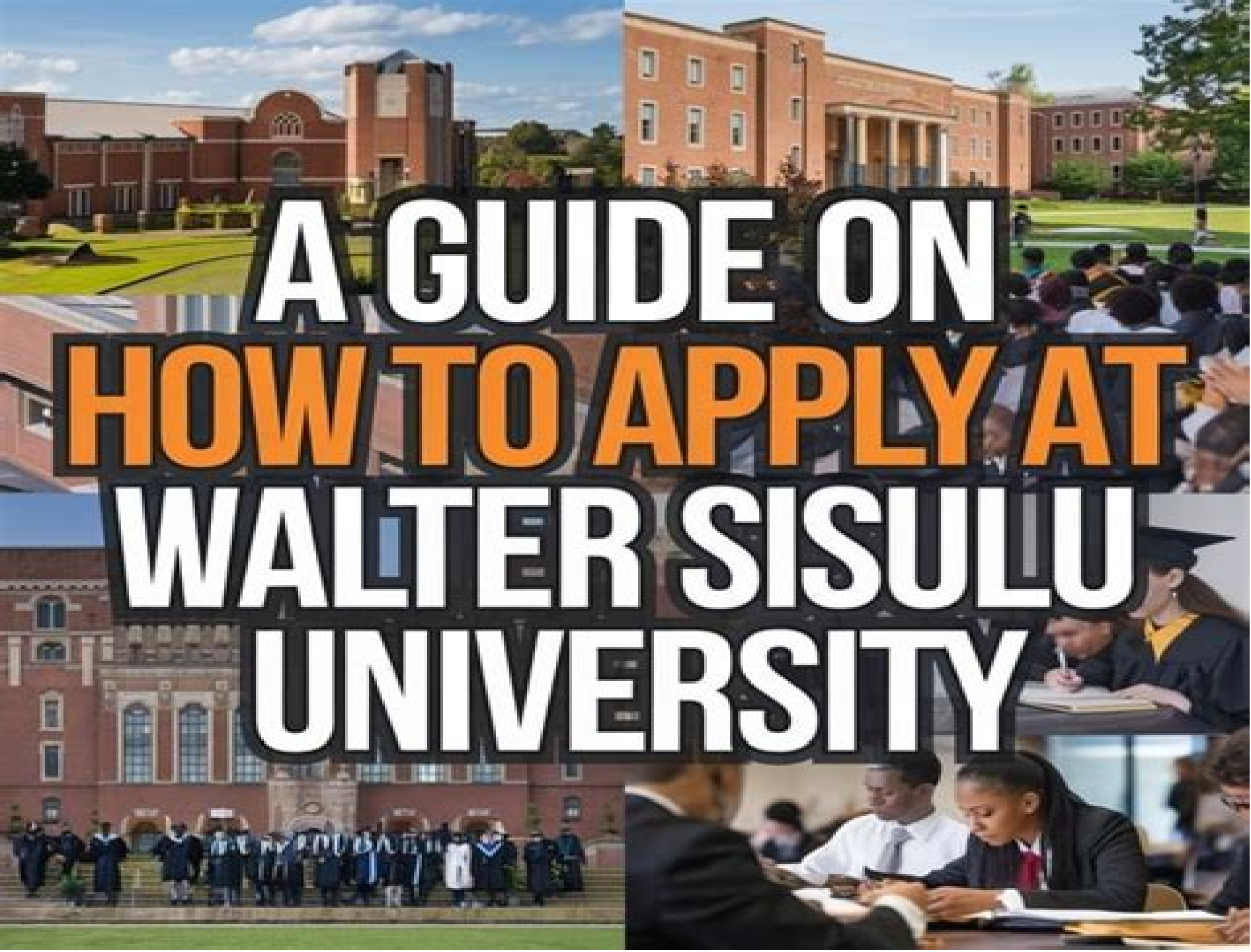

levels as represented by the African Union What is needed is a radical reevaluation of Africa's security architecture and approach to security This necessitates pooling sovereignty on a continental and global level It necessitates less state centric responses that include civil society and the business community as equal partners of states in order to collectively confront insecurity in the age of the Anthropocene The authors are academics policy makers and military veterans who have worked in building capacity on the African continent The book is comprehensive in scope strong on theory pragmatic in policy and reflects experience from the field The authors approach makes the book easy interesting and intriguing **Symposium**
