While some individuals spoke out on behalf of Jewish people during the Holocaust, many countries did little. There were many reasons that they did not act more forcefully to help relocate or rescue Jews. Firstly, in general, many countries did not want to interfere or help the Jews because their focus was more on winning or advancing in the war. Resources and strategic minds were all focused on the war effort, and leaders feared sparking further war with Germany. Additionally, many countries had strict immigration policies. These policies were often exacerbated by anti-Semitism and a fear of a large influx of Jews entering their countries. Many countries, such as America, had limits on the number of immigrants allowed in from each country. There was even a fear that the immigrants could be Nazi spies trying to learn information about the host country. Finally, the reality was that there was minimal awareness in relation to the atrocities being committed on the Jewish people by the Nazis. It was not until after the liberations began that the truth was finally brought to light, and people finally began to understand the near genocide that had been taking place.

2. And this is just the beginning... with so many other governments and groups who either collaborated or did very little to openly aid or rescue Jews during the Holocaust, how does this help you "evaluate" what happened during that horrible event/era?

In order to best evaluate what happened during the horrible event that was the Holocaust, it is important to examine those things that were done and NOT done in relation to this attempted genecide. It becomes crucial to ask where the line is drawn during wartime in relation to the leaders of countries who can offer humanitarian assistance and speak out on behalf of the voiceless. How does prejudice and bias impact the responses that are offered? Evaluation of the attrocities that occurred during the Holocaust and the responses of many governments and groups who either collaborated or did very little to aid or rescue Jews becomes absolutely critical in the effort to ensure that such events are never permitted to take hold and fester in the civilized world, ever again.
