Sustainable Economic Growth in Russia Ararat L. Osipian, 2023-07-25. This book presents a theoretical and empirical investigation of sustainable economic growth in Russia. The ill planned transition in the 1990s from planned economy to market economy resulted in a sharp decline in national production, however Russian economic growth was evident in the 2000s and 2010s. Osipian here analyses whether Russia has potential to achieve sustainable economic growth, filling a gap between the continuous presence of volatile economic growth in Russia and the lack of scholarly literature in the field. This book considers Russia's economic transition within the set of early modern classical exogenous and endogenous theories of economic growth. At the same time this book considers the phenomenon of sustainable economic growth in the context of the post Soviet transition. Such a contextualization allows for finding and highlighting certain features and processes within economic transition that were earlier neglected by the scholars, including primarily the possibility of not only recovering after economic and financial crises but also initiating sustainable economic growth. It identifies the place and role of human capital in economic growth within the market type post transitional Russian economy and concludes that human capital accumulation is key for sustainable economic growth.

Business Leaders and New Varieties of Capitalism in Post-Communist Europe Katharina Bluhm, Bernd Martens, Vera Trappmann, 2013-09-23. Business leaders exert extraordinary influence on institution building in market economies but they think and act within institutional settings. This book combines both an elite approach with a varieties of capitalism approach. Comparing Poland, Hungary and East and West Germany we perceive the transformations in East Central Europe and in Germany after 1989 as being intertwined. Based on a joint survey this book seeks to measure the level of the convergence of ideas among European business leaders, assuming it to be more extensive than the institutional convergence expected under the dominance of neoliberal discourse. Analyzing the institutional framework, organizational features like size, ownership and labour relations and subjective characteristics like age, social origin, career patterns and attitudes of the recent business elites we found significant differences between countries and the types of organization. The growing importance of economic degrees and internationalization shows astonishingly little explanatory power on the views of business leaders. The idea of a coordinated market economy is still relatively widespread among Germans while their Hungarian and Polish counterparts are more likely to display a minimalist view of corporate responsibility to society and adverse attitudes towards employee representation. However their attitudes frequently tend to be inconsistent which mirrors the mixed type of capitalism in East Central Europe.

Is the European Union Capable of Integrating Diverse Models of

Capitalism? Alison Johnston, Aidan Regan, 2021-03-31 The 2009 European sovereign debt crisis and the EU's policy response to it have prompted scholars to re think whether diverse national models of capitalism can thrive within the European Union. EU: Are some national economic systems better suited to adapt to European integration than others and if so why? Contributions within this volume provide a qualified yes to these questions raised, concluding that the EU favors export led growth models while it penalizes and discourages domestic consumption oriented growth paths, particularly those that are financed by debt accumulation.
