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War of Intervention in Angola Adrien Fontanellaz, Tom Cooper, José Augusto Matos, 2021-06-23 War of Intervention in Angola Volume 4 continues the coverage of the operational history of the Angolan Air Force and Air Defense Force FAPA DAA as told by Angolan and Cuban sources in the period 1985 1988 Many accounts of this conflict better known in the West as the Border War or the Bush War as named by its South African participants consider the operations of the FAPA DAA barely worth commentary At most they mention a few air combats involving Mirage F 1 interceptors of the South African Air Force SAAF in 1987 and 1988 and perhaps a little about the activity of the FAPA DAA s MiG 23s However a closer study of Angolan and Cuban sources reveals an entirely different image of the air war over Angola in the 1980s indeed it reveals the extent to which the flow of the entire war was dictated by the availability or the lack of air power These issues strongly influenced the planning and conduct of operations by the commanders of the Angolan and Cuban forces Based on extensive research with the help of Angolan and Cuban sources War of Intervention in Angola Volume 4 traces the Angolan and Cuban application of air power between 1985 1988 during which it came of age and the capabilities intentions and the combat operations of the air forces The volume is illustrated with 100 rarely seen photographs half a dozen maps and 15 color profiles and provides a unique source of reference on this subject

The Rif War Javier Garcia de Gabiola, 2023-06-30 The Rif War in rugged northern Morocco is remembered for romantic films and novels about the French Foreign Legion such as Beau Geste In reality the French intervention although very important was late and secondary in importance to that of the Spanish The second volume of The Rif War begins with the aftermath of the Disaster of Annual and documents the Spanish response and reconquest of Morocco While the renewed campaign remained largely one of columns outposts and fortresses it also took on the character of a very modern war with the use of armored vehicles trench warfare aircraft chemical weapons and large scale amphibious landings by combined arms forces Indeed the Spanish landing at Alhucemas conducted with French naval support would become the subject of study by the Allies in the Second World War Yet despite these innovations including a number of firsts in the history of conflict and in particular of the history of conflict in Africa Spain would continue to suffer heavy casualties in a bitterly fought contest for control of Morocco Volume

persecution judicial killings corruption and economic mismanagement Amin's rule drove thousands into exile With Tanzanian leader Julius Nyerere offering sanctuary to Uganda's ousted president Milton Obote Uganda **Mar Verde** José Augusto Matos,2021-09-30 In the early hours of 22 November 1970 six Portuguese warships surrounded Conakry the capital of the Republic of Guinea on the West African coast Taking advantage of the darkness of the night a military force landed on the northern and southern coasts of the sleeping city At the head of these men was a young Portuguese marine officer Commander Alpoim Calvo who had been appointed to command this secret operation codenamed Green Sea Mar Verde in Portuguese The main objective of the invasion was to promote a coup d'état in the former French colony and overthrow the regime of President Sékou Touré who supported the guerrillas of the PAIGC African Party for the Independence of Guinea and Cape Verde who were fighting for the independence of Portuguese Guinea The invaders also sought to destroy the naval resources that the guerrillas and the Guinean navy had in the port of Conakry capture the leader of the party Amílcar Cabral and rescue a group of Portuguese soldiers held in a PAIGC prison The incursion would not have the expected success concerning the coup d'état and Portugal would be condemned by international organizations for the invasion of a sovereign state but this operation would remain in the memory of many as the most daring carried out during the colonial war in Africa although the Portuguese regime never recognized its involvement **Ethiopian-Eritrean Wars** Tom Cooper,Adrien Fontanellaz,2018-07-31

Ethiopia a country of ancient origins in eastern Africa remains a military powerhouse of that continent until our days Nowadays involved in the war in neighboring Somalia Ethiopia was also involved in half a dozen of other armed conflicts over the last 60 years Crucial between these was the Eritrean War of Independence Fought 1961-1991 this was one of the biggest armed conflicts on the African continent especially if measured by numbers of involved combatants It included a wide spectrum of operations from classic counterinsurgency COIN to conventional warfare in mountains with the latter being one of the most complex and most demanding undertakings possible to conduct by a military force Campaigns run during the Eritrean War of Independence often included large formations of relatively well equipped forces led by well trained commanders along well thought out plans based on homegrown doctrine The air power played a crucial although not necessarily decisive role in many of the battles Nevertheless most of the details about this conflict remain unknown in the wider public Similarly relatively few Western observers are aware of relations between the Eritrean liberation movements and various dissident and insurgent movements inside Ethiopia although the synergy of these eventually led to the downfall of the so called Derg government in 1991 While the first volume in this mini series spanned the history of wars between Ethiopia and Eritrea between 1961 and 1988 the second covers the period since Correspondingly it is providing coverage of military operations that led to the fall of the Derg government in Ethiopia of 1991 the period of Eritrean military buildup and a complete reorganization of the Ethiopian military in the 1990s and concludes with the first detailed account of the so called Badme War fought between Ethiopia and Eritrea in period 1998-2001 It is illustrated by many contemporary photographs

maps and color profiles *The Paras* John P. Cann, 2017-02-22 Portuguese paratroopers or paras began as a stepchild of the army and found a home in the Portuguese Air Force in 1955 Initially the post World War Two Portuguese Army seemed to have had mixed emotions about the need for elite special purpose forces that operated in small units with the attendant flexibility and elevated lethality Shock troops have been traditionally controversial and even the vaunted military theorist Baron Karl von Clausewitz saw little point in them The history of the paras in the Portuguese Army is illustrative of this ambivalent view Nevertheless in a war of the weak in which insurgents avoid government strengths and exploit its vulnerabilities using agility deception and imagination such small crack government units are particularly well suited to counterinsurgency operations This appreciation emerged with the threat of a new kind of war in Portuguese Africa an insurgency and the new and visionary Air Force well understood the potential of paras when combined with the mobility of the helicopter The Air Force saw an urgent need for troops who could fight an unconventional war who could not only defeat an enemy but separate him from the population in which he sought concealment and support and on which he depended for funding recruits and intelligence These were specialised warfighters who in one minute were physically destroying an insidious enemy and in the next administering aid and support and protecting a vulnerable population These were just the troops that Portugal would require for military success in its approaching battle fought between 1961 and 1974 to retain its African possessions and this vision would be realized on the African battlefield with devastating consequences This book tells the paras story as researched from Portuguese sources It details how they were formed and trained and how they developed their imaginative effective and feared tactics and applied them in operations to protect the population from insurgent predations and destroy a vicious enemy **Operations 'Leopard' and 'Red Bean' Kolwezi 1978** Daniel
