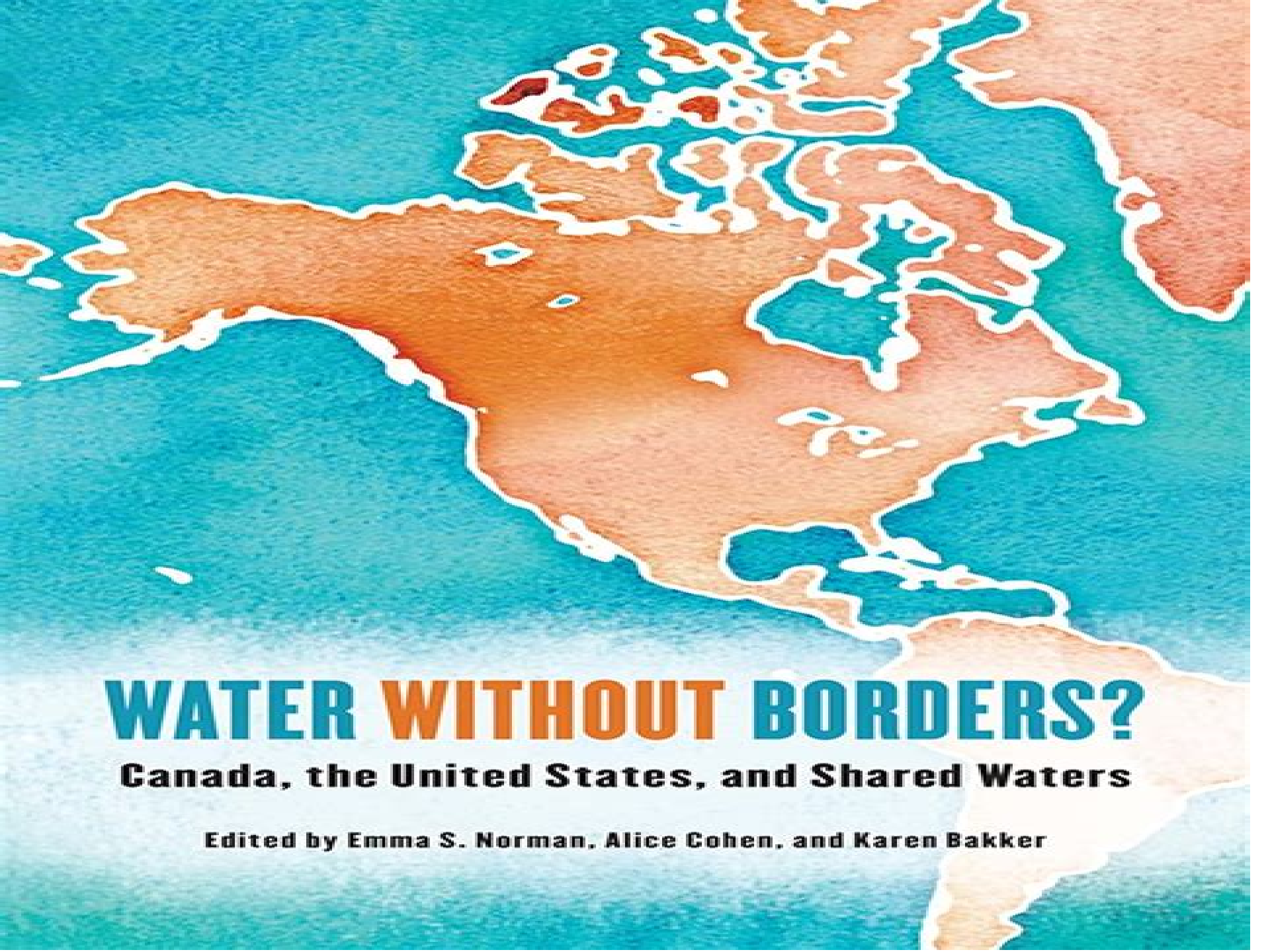

Ecoregionalism Jon Marco Church, 2020-05-25 This book provides a comprehensive understanding of environmental regionalism at the international level analyzing the concept and identifying recurring patterns from six in depth case studies While ecoregions or environmental regions are defined on ecological boundaries rather than administrative criteria ecoregionalism is the idea that regional dynamics should cluster around ecoregions while ecoregionalization is the tendency of regional dynamics to cluster around ecoregions Focusing on the international level this book presents six cases of ecoregional processes from around the world and the regional environmental agreements two are terrestrial the Alps and the Andes two are marine the Mediterranean Sea and the Baltic Sea two are related to freshwater ecosystems the Amu Darya in Central Asia and the Great Lakes in North America The book analyzes both ecoregional processes focused on the environment as well as intersectoral ecoregional processes The case studies are analyzed based on the ecoregional governance framework developed by the author for this book Despite the diversity of context the similarity of the governance system of the six cases is striking Several recurring patterns have been identified which may also extend to the subnational level They are not design principles but may be taken into consideration for the design or redesign of current and future regional environmental agreements and processes This book will be of great interest to students and scholars of environmental politics natural resource management spatial planning and international relations

Levelling the Lake Jamie Benidickson, 2019-02-15 Stretching across Ontario Manitoba and Minnesota the Lake of the Woods and Rainy Lake basin spans boundaries and jurisdictions Levelling the Lake explores a century and a half of social economic and legal arrangements through which the resources and environment of the Lake of the Woods and Rainy Lake watershed have been harnessed and harmed Jamie Benidickson traces the environmental consequences of mining forest industries commercial fishing hydro electricity production and recreation as well as their often unanticipated impacts on local residents including Indigenous communities which encouraged new legal and institutional responses Assessing the transition from primary resource extraction toward sustainable development at a watershed level Levelling the Lake also shows how interjurisdictional and transboundary issues many involving the Canada US International Joint Commission continue to play a significant role throughout the region

However, these cases are consistently underexposed and understudied in the policy literature, which for various reasons tends to focus on policy mistakes and learning from failures rather than successes. In fact, studies of public policy successes are rare, not just in Canada but the world over, although this has started to change (McConnell 2010, 2017; Compton, Luetjens, Mintrom, t' Hart 2019). Like those publications, the aims of *Policy Success in Canada* are to see, describe, acknowledge and promote learning from past and present instances of highly effective and highly valued public policymaking. This exercise will be done through detailed examination of selected case studies of policy success in different eras, governments and policy domains in Canada. This book project is embedded in a broader project led by t' Hart and OUP exploring policy successes globally and regionally.
