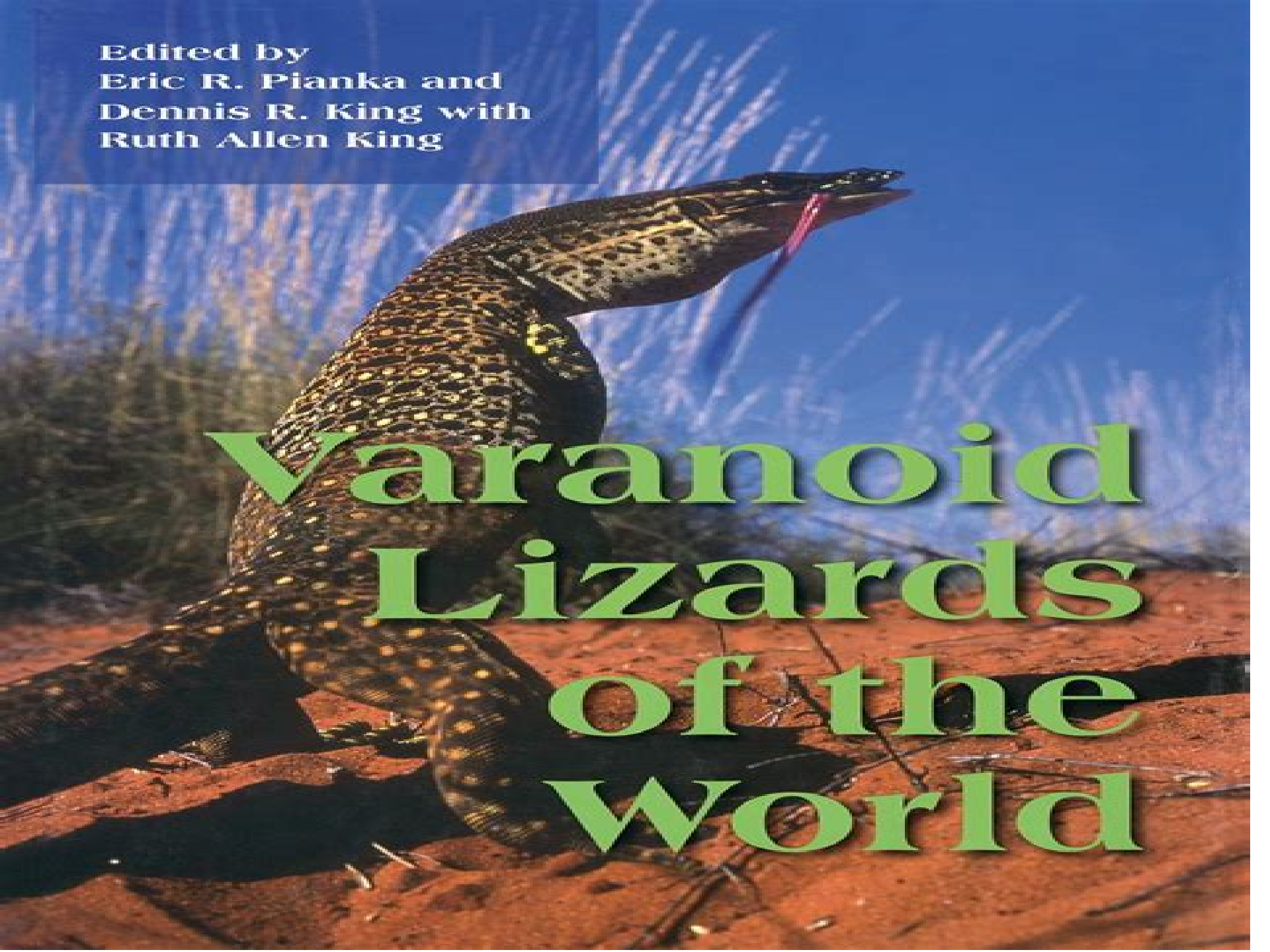

Notably over this period the first known extinction post European settlement of an Australian reptile species occurred an indication of the increasingly urgent need for better knowledge and management of this fauna Six key recommendations are presented to improve the conservation management and plight of Australian squamates This Action Plan represents an essential resource for research scientists conservation biologists conservation managers environmental consultants policy makers from Commonwealth and State Territory governments and the herpetological community
