all under strength short on equipment and poorly trained kept in the dark about the attack until the last minute they fought in total ignorance of their opponents or the terrain Ultimately Caddick Adams concludes that the German assault was doomed to failure from the start Aided by an intimate knowledge of the battlefield itself and over twenty years of personal battlefield experience Caddick Adams has produced the most compelling and complete account of the Bulge yet written
