abandon the colony in large groups heading north to the Southern Ocean The adults leave at the same time traveling one thousand kilometers eastward across the Ross Sea to a sea ice sanctuary for molting During this journey they must gain enough weight to survive the month long molt when every feather is replaced and the birds cannot enter the water to feed After the molt many if not most return to the colony to breed once again For the males this means another fast this time for 120 days as they incubate their eggs.
