My Odyssey Stephane Groueff, 2003

In 1944 when Communism devastated Eastern Europe it uprooted millions setting the new Displaced Persons adrift most often to a tragic fate. By unusual luck young Stephane Groueff a Bulgarian landed on more hospitable shores. Spared from the destruction of his family and home after a happy privileged childhood in a small Balkan kingdom his eventful Odyssey threw him into the fascinating life of a Paris Match foreign correspondent. It led him to romantic experiences lived against the backdrop of Montmartre nightclubs, Egyptian pyramids, opulent Irish castles or Alpine ski resorts and involved him in anti Communist exile activities. The reader of his candid narrative finds the budding historian of the Manhattan Project at the side of general Groves, the maker of the atomic bomb follows him as a chronicler of science research at oceanography expeditions in the Pacific at the Mt Palomar telescope or on the South Pole and meets him again in Mexico and at the service of the Sultan of Oman. His reportages bring him to Cape Canaveral and Saigon to refugee camps in Thailand and glamorous Hollywood. The bittersweet tale abounds with celebrities, famous friends and amusing anecdotes but is also filled with incurable nostalgia and heartbreaking details of the author's family's sufferings. Unexpectedly a miracle interrupts the Displaced Person's voyage: the Communist regime collapses and Groueff can finally return to his native land. The circle is completed. The red carpet awaits him but 46 years had passed and most people he loved are no longer there to welcome him.

Journeys with Emperors Gerald L. Kooyman, Jim Mastro, 2023-11-29

With stunning photographs from the ice edge a firsthand account of a researcher's time in Antarctica and of the perilous journeys of the world's largest penguin species, the iconic emperor. Nearly all emperor penguin colonies are extremely remote of the sixty-six known; fewer than thirty have been visited by humans and even fewer have been the subject of successful research programs. One of the largest known emperor penguin colonies is found on a narrow band of sea ice attached to the Antarctic continent. In *Journeys with Emperors* Gerald L. Kooyman and Jim Mastro take us to this far flung colony in the Ross Sea showing us how scientists gained access to it and what they learned while living among the penguins as they raised their chicks. The primary mission was to record the birds' activities at sea and the data revealed important aspects of emperor penguin behavior and physiology for instance that in the course of hunting for food some of the penguins dive to depths of greater than five hundred meters, a third of a mile which is deeper than for any other diving bird. The researchers also discovered that crucially most of the emperor's life is actually spent at sea with fledged chicks and adults making separate perilous journeys through icy water. When chick nurturing is complete the fledglings

abandon the colony in large groups heading north to the Southern Ocean. The adults leave at the same time traveling one thousand kilometers eastward across the Ross Sea to a sea ice sanctuary for molting. During this journey they must gain enough weight to survive the month long molt when every feather is replaced and the birds cannot enter the water to feed. After the molt many if not most return to the colony to breed once again. For the males this means another fast this time for 120 days as they incubate their eggs. The nearness of the colony to the ice edge spared the penguins the long energy draining march for which other colonies are well known. It also allowed researchers to observe the penguins' departures to and arrivals from their foraging journeys as well as their dangerous interactions with leopard seals and killer whales. Centuries ago when penguins were first encountered by European explorers they were not thought to be birds but rather a fish-like relative. Subsequent accumulation of knowledge has shown penguins to be an avian species with unrivaled aquatic attributes owing to a number of evolutionary adaptations: shape change, low drag, ability to regulate buoyancy and extraordinary surface compliancy from their featheration. They are indeed the most extremely specialized diving bird, having given up flight which otherwise is hugely advantageous to the benefit of underwater prowess such as speed, maneuverability and an ability to exploit an extraordinary range of depths. This flightlessness however also comes with costs that are substantial for a seabird such as the inability to cover large distances quickly in reaction to ephemeral prey and the energy needed to cope with moving through an aqueous environment which is more resistant than air. For penguins the high energetic costs in exploiting the ocean environment thus makes them especially sensitive to changes in food availability or their access to their prey. While a number of penguin books cover the

natural history mainly of breeding aspects few address in much detail the incredible aquatic nature of these creatures A huge amount of information has been amassed over recent past decades thanks to dramatic advances in microelectronics bio logging and maturation of some long term studies of penguin life history This work represents an integration of all these data with charts maps and graphs along with richly illustrated photos by experts in the field **The Antarctic Dictionary**
