diagnosis is accepted the practitioner must be able to explain how the behaviors differ from normal developmental behaviors In Hope s case medical treatment would not be effective in reducing symptoms because her environment never changed The sexual abuse never stopped and Hope was merely medicated into submission Once the need for medications for such a young girl reached three the psychiatrist should have started asking other questions However since psychiatry categorizes the individual once labeled it stops questioning the diagnosis as being potentially false and thereby confines treatment to the social standard of normal
