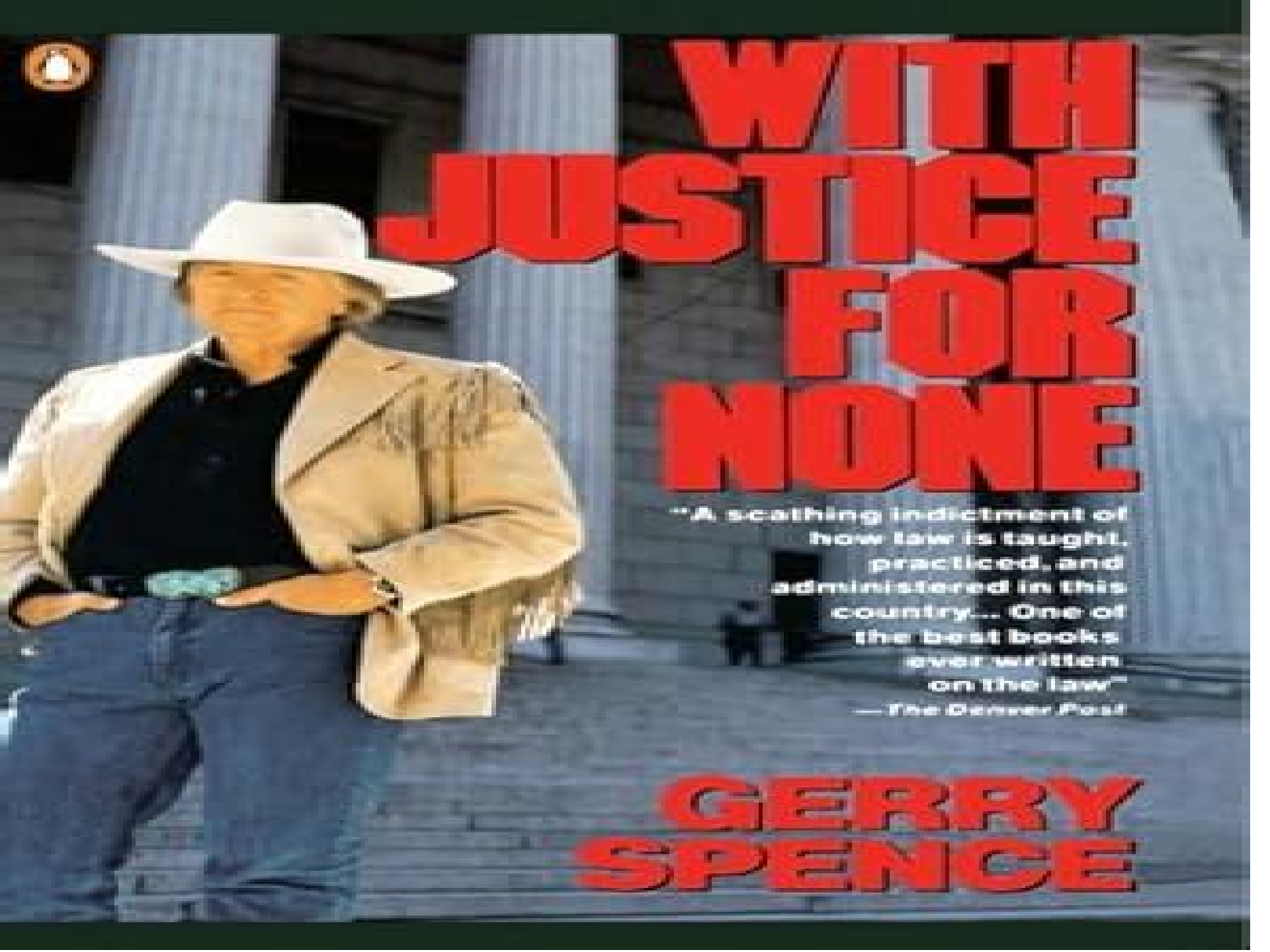

Friedman, 2003 *Myths of the Free Market* is arguably the most significant book in economics and politics since John Maynard Keynes It systematically presents a broad range of telling criticisms of free market economics criticisms that have not been presented elsewhere Despite our genuine faith in the free market laissez faire has not maximized wealth When we moved from the purer free market policies of the 1920s and early 1930s to the proto socialism of Roosevelt our economic growth increased As we have moved back to a purer free market growth has slowed We have lagged our trading partners who have mixed economies Nor is this new In the late 1800s the mixed economies of Bismarck s Germany and Meiji Japan outperformed the relatively free market economies of Great Britain and France It is worse Even in principle laissez faire cannot work it is incompatible with institutions that increase wealth Patent protection is one example easily generalized It is worse yet Laissez faire promotes the excessive concentration of wealth and exposes us all to avoidable danger Over the last millennium there has been a 200 300 year cycle of wealth dispersion Each time wealth disparity grew beyond a critical point it presaged decline and disaster for all of society We now have the greatest disparity of wealth in our history Kenneth

This is the remarkable story of an individual who experienced severe stress starting in the womb Growing up in a highly dysfunctional family he used intellectualization as a defense against overwhelming emotional pain A high academic achiever this young man was on the Dean s List at Brown University when he suffered a catastrophic neurological collapse Labeled as schizophrenic he was on the verge of death as his twentieth birthday approached Starting to jog he avoided his demise Four years later this individual found psychoanalyst Erich Fromm s *The Sane Society* while browsing in a bookstore Unable to work or communicate normally with people he began a long intellectual odyssey which ultimately involved the reading of thousands of books about American society Miraculously transformed by a bodywork technique developed by Moshe

Feldenkrais he continued to live with severe stress due to his lack of social skills and the crazy making institutions of an aggressive society Nine years after relearning to use his body properly this man discovered psychoanalyst Alice Miller s For Your Own Good Hidden Cruelty in Child rearing and The Roots of Violence Reading many other books about child abuse and human development he began to understand the reasons which had caused his ordeal This engrossing story is a unique combination of memoir and academic study People interested in psychology education human development American culture and social criticism will find much to ponder in it In the Hands of the People William L.
