Hansen, 2022-06-21 There s no denying that the U S Mexico border region has changed in the past twenty years With the emergence of the North American Free Trade Agreement NAFTA the curtailment of welfare programs and more aggressive efforts by the United States to seal the border against undocumented migrants the prospect of seeking a livelihood particularly for women has become more tenuous in the twenty first century In the face of the ironic juxtaposition of free trade and limited mobility this book takes a new look at women on both sides of the border to portray them as active participants in the changing structures of life often engaging in political struggles The contributions including several chapters by Mexican as well as U S scholars examine environmental and socioeconomic conditions on the border as they shape and are shaped by both daily life at the local level and the global economy The contributors focus on issues related to migration both short and long term empowerment especially reflecting shifts in women's consciousness in the workplace and political and social activism in border communities. The chapters consider a broad range of topics such as the changing gender composition of the maguiladora work force over the past decade and border women s non governmental organizations and political activism In most of the studies both sides of the border are considered to provide insights into differences created by an international boundary and similarities produced by cross border interactions Together these chapters show the border region to be a dynamic social economic cultural and political context in which women face both obstacles and opportunities for change and make clear the vital role that women play in shaping the border region and their own lives This collection builds on Susan Tiano and Vicki Ruiz's groundbreaking volume Women on the U S Mexico Border by continuing to show the human face of changes wrought by manufacturing and militarization By illustrating the current state of social science research on gender and women s lives in the region it offers fresh perspectives on the material reality of women's daily lives in this culturally and historically rich region Geography and Social Justice in the Classroom Todd W. Schreiber, 2018-03-13 Examining how these women and their families undocumented migrants are using film video and other documentary media to challenge surveillance detention and deportation As debates over immigration increasingly become flashpoints of political contention in the United States a variety of advocacy groups social service organizations filmmakers and artists have provided undocumented migrants with the tools and training to document their experiences In The Undocumented Everyday Rebecca M Schreiber examines the significance of self representation by undocumented Mexican and Central American migrants arguing that by centering their own subjectivity and presence through their use of documentary media these migrants are effectively challenging intensified regimes of state surveillance and liberal strategies that emphasize visibility as a form of empowerment and inclusion Schreiber explores documentation as both an aesthetic practice based on the visual conventions of social realism and a state administered means of identification and control As Schreiber shows by visualizing new ways of belonging not necessarily defined by citizenship these migrants are remaking documentary media combining formal visual strategies with those of amateur photography and performative elements to create a mixed genre aesthetic In doing so they make political claims and create new forms of protection for migrant communities experiencing increased surveillance detention and deportation

Mexican Women in American Factories Carolyn Tuttle,2012-11-01 Prior to the millennium economists and policy makers argued that free trade between the United States and Mexico would benefit both Americans and Mexicans They believed that NAFTA would be a win win proposition that would offer U S companies new markets for their products and Mexicans the hope of living in a more developed country with the modern conveniences of wealthier nations Blending rigorous economic and statistical analysis with concern for the people affected Mexican Women in American Factories offers the first

assessment of whether NAFTA has fulfilled these expectations by examining its socioeconomic impact on workers in a Mexican border town Carolyn Tuttle led a group that interviewed 620 women maquila workers in Nogales Sonora Mexico The responses from this representative sample refute many of the hopeful predictions made by scholars before NAFTA and reveal instead that little has improved for maquila workers The women s stories make it plain that free trade has created more low paying jobs in sweatshops where workers are exploited Families of maquila workers live in one or two room houses with no running water no drainage and no heat The multinational companies who operate the maquilas consistently break Mexican labor laws by requiring women to work more than nine hours a day six days a week without medical benefits while the minimum wage they pay workers is insufficient to feed their families These findings will make a crucial contribution to debates over free trade CAFTA DR and the impact of globalization The U.S.-Mexico Transborder Region Carlos G.
