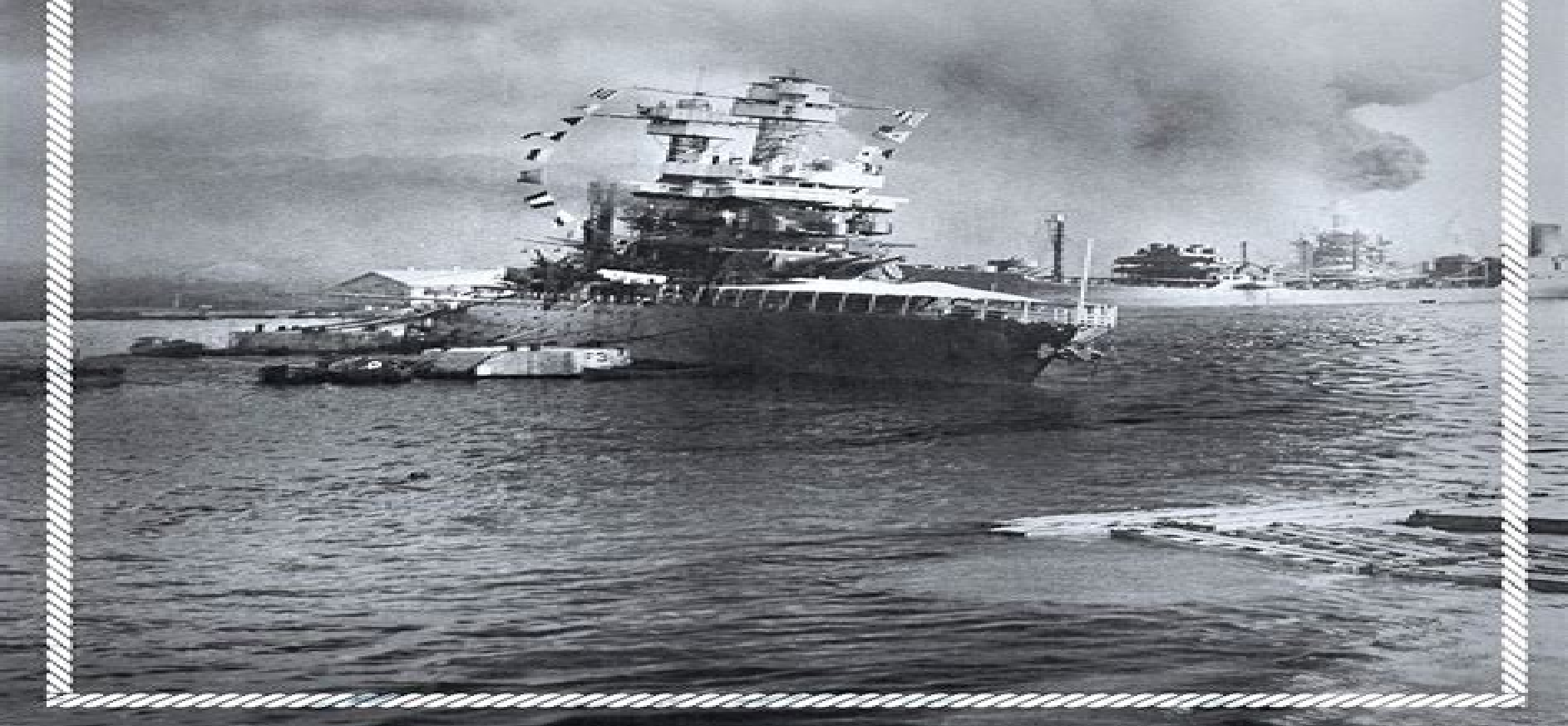

Whirlwind Richard Freeman, 2018-12-24 In just six months America turned the rout of Pearl Harbor into the victories of Coral Sea and Midway *Whirlwind War in the Pacific* tells the story of how America achieved this staggering turnaround using accounts of the three key Pacific battles of 1942 Pearl Harbor Hinge of War Just over seventy years ago the world witnessed one of the most audacious and villainous surprise attacks in history While Tokyo and Washington talked peace hundreds of Japanese war planes descended on the Sunday morning calm of Pearl Harbor on 7 December 1941 In less than 90 minutes four battleships were sunk four more badly damaged and hundreds of American warplanes lay burnt out in tangled heaps on the runways The story of the raid is one of Japanese military skill meeting American courage As airfields and ships were attacked as planes caught fire and ships capsized the men of the army and navy heroically fought to save the planes the ships and their compatriots Coral Sea 1942 After the devastating attack on Pearl Harbour the Americans suffered setback after setback in the Pacific In May 1942 the Japanese were poised to take Port Moresby in New Guinea At all costs the Americans had to stop them Admiral Frank Fletcher was dispatched with two aircraft carriers Yorktown and Lexington with orders to destroy the Japanese invasion force The fate of the Pacific was in the balance Coral Sea 1942 tells the dramatic story of that conflict The great Coral Sea victory came at a price Pilots died in dog fights crippled planes fell into the sea damaged planes crashed onto carrier flight decks and pilots found themselves stranded on remote islands But the battle was an American triumph Japan entered it as an aggressor at the peak of her imperial power She left the battle with her dominance shattered The tide had turned Midway Never was there a naval battle like Midway It was fought at a place thousands of miles from land by hundreds of planes over distances of hundreds of miles It saw four massive Japanese aircraft carriers pitted against three similarly huge American carriers in a battle for domination of the Pacific The battle is the story of the young Japanese empire seeking to challenge the established industrial power of America Japan was ready to risk all in one mighty attempt to drive the United States Navy from the Pacific Ocean The battle that followed raged over three days full of set backs and disaster for each side But Admirals Yamamoto and Nagumo had over reached themselves and suffered the greatest naval defeat in history America entered Midway on the defensive still a hesitant participant in the war She left the battle as the world's first super power *Whirlwind War In The Pacific* is a brilliant narrative history of three of the crucial naval battles of the Second World War It is essential reading for anyone interested in the period Richard Freeman graduated in mathematics before following a career in distance education He now writes on naval history His other books include *The Great Edwardian Naval Feud* *Whirlwind* Barrett Tillman, 2010-03-02 WHIRLWIND is the first book to tell the complete awe inspiring story of the Allied air war against Japan the most important strategic bombing campaign in history From the audacious Doolittle raid in 1942 to the atomic bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki in 1945 award winning historian Barrett Tillman recounts the saga from the perspectives of American and British aircrews who flew unprecedented missions over thousands of miles of ocean as

well as of the generals and admirals who commanded them. Whether describing the experiences of bomber crews based in China or the Marianas fighter pilots on Iwo Jima or carrier aviators at sea, Tillman provides vivid details of the lives of the fliers and their support personnel. Whirlwind takes readers into the cockpits and gun turrets of the mighty B-29 Superfortress, the largest bomber built up to that time. Tillman dramatically recreates the sweep of wartime emotions that crews endured on fifteen-hour missions grappling with the extreme tedium of cramped spaces and with adrenaline spikes in flak-studded skies, knowing that a bailout would put them at the mercy of a merciless enemy or an unforgiving sea. A major character is the controversial and brilliant General Curtis LeMay, who rewrote strategic bombing tactics. His command's fire bombing missions incinerated fully half of Tokyo and many other cities, crippling Japan's industry while still failing to force surrender. Whirlwind examines the immense logistics and construction efforts necessary to support Superfortresses in Asia and the Mariana Islands, as well as the tireless efforts of engineers to build huge air bases from scratch. It also describes the unheralded missions that American bomber crews flew from the Aleutian Islands to Japan's northernmost Kuril Islands. Never has the Japanese side of the story been so thoroughly examined. If Washington, D.C. represented a second front in Army-Navy rivalry, the situation in Tokyo approached a full-contact sport. Tillman's description of Japan's willfully inadequate approach to civil defense is eye-opening. Similarly, he examines the mind-set in Tokyo's war cabinet, which ignored the atomic destruction of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, requiring the emperor's personal intervention to avert a ghastly Allied invasion. Tillman shows how, despite the Allies' ultimate success, mistakes and shortsighted policies made victory more costly in lives and effort. He faults the lack of a unified command for allowing the Army, Air Forces, and the Navy to pursue parochial goals at the expense of the larger mission, and he questions the premature commitment of the enormously sophisticated B-29 to the most primitive theater in India and China. Whirlwind is one of the last histories of World War II written with the contribution of men who fought in it. With unexcelled macro and microperspectives, Whirlwind is destined to become a standard reference on the war on multiservice operations and on the human capacity for individual heroism and national folly.

The Pacific Naval War 1941-1945 David Wragg, 2011-07-12. This vividly detailed WWII history chronicles the bitter conflict at sea between Allied and Japanese naval forces. The Pacific War was primarily fought at sea. Naval power allowed the Japanese to mount their attack on Pearl Harbor and then advance westwards and southwards. It also enabled the Allies to strike back and even take the war to Japan itself. The tide turned very quickly with the US victory at Midway in June of 1942, ending any Japanese hope of domination. The book begins with the decisions that led Japan into war and the difficult situation faced by the Royal Navy elsewhere. It then describes how, within a couple of years, the Royal Navy was able to send the strongest and most balanced fleet in its history to severely disrupt Japanese operations. Historian David Wragg also covers how the Royal Australian Navy developed into a viable naval force, ready to become a major fleet in the immediate postwar years. The progress of the war is supported by eyewitness accounts from those involved in the fighting at sea.
